## (STATE FOOD FESTIVAL)


- Proprietorship: 1-4
- Registrants will set up their eatery at the tables allotted to them.
- Registrants may sell any variety of food but must clearly mention the food name, veg or non veg and the origin state/geographical indication of the food.
- Registrations limited to first 15 entries (10 from faculty and 5 from students)
- Food price per plate must not exceed ₹100 for veg and ₹150 for non-veg.
- Registrants will be responsible for the cleanliness and hygiene of their stall vicinity. Strict action will be taken for littering.
- Use of plastic cutleries is strictly prohibited. Alternatively, biodegradable cutleries such as sal leaf plates and cups or paper plates could be used.
- Registrants should sell only 1 type of food and it should be different from that of other registrants to assure monopoly.





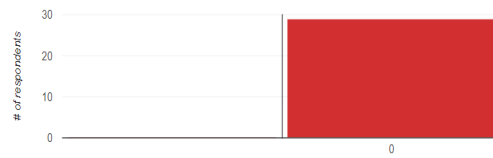

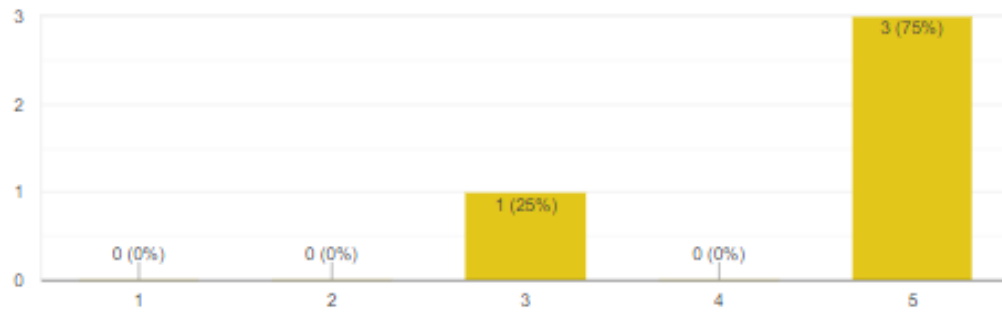

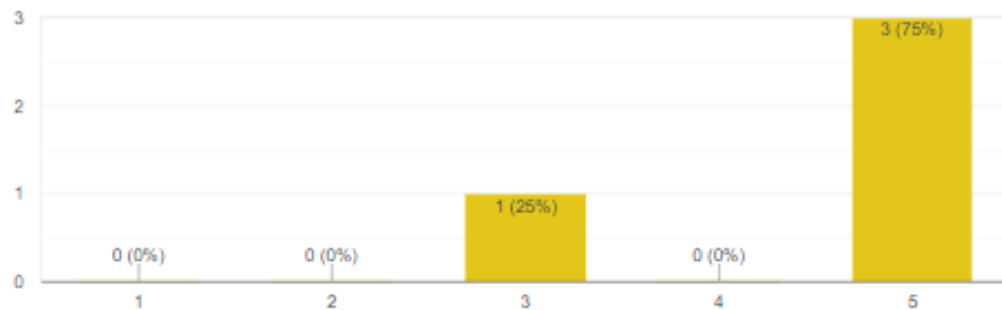
