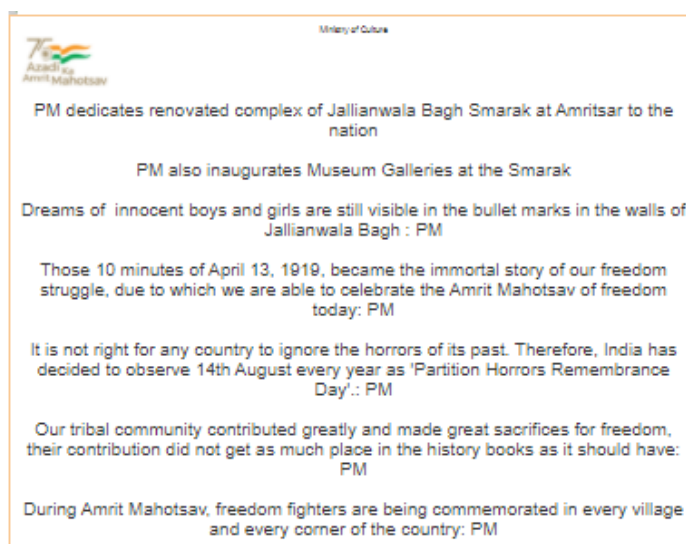

- An Indian independence activist born on 22 December 1924 in Gohpur, Assam
- She was a part of the Mrityu Bahini, a death squad comprising groups of youth from the Gohpur district, during the Quit India Movement
- Attained martyrdom on **20 September, 1942** when she courageously faced bullets while making a fiercely determined effort to hoist the national flag on a police station
- Popularly known as the '17-year-old martyr of Assam'

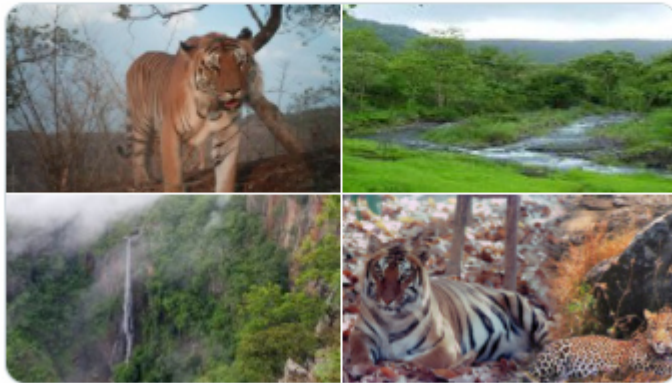

Chempakaraman Pillai
(15 September 1891 to 26 May 1934)

- Born in Trivandrum (Thiruvananthapuram), Kerala on **15 September 1891**
- Political activist and revolutionary
- Founded the International Pro-India Committee in Zürich and launched the publication 'Pro-India'
- Key member of the Berlin Committee (known after 1915 as the Indian Independence Committee)
- Associated with nationalists like Subhash Chandra Bose and Virendranath Chattopadhyay
- Foreign minister of the Provisional Government of India set up in Kabul, Afghanistan on 1 December 1915

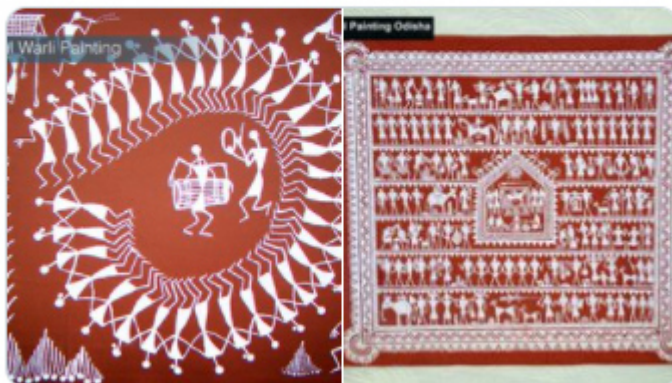

'Komagata Maru' Incident

29 September 1914



In April 1914, 376 passengers from Punjab, led by Baba Gurdit Singh, sailed from Hong Kong on 'Komagata Maru', a Japanese steamship. British authorities did not permit them to disembark at their destination in Vancouver, Canada. Forced to return, Komagata Maru arrived at Budge Budge, Calcutta, in September. A violent confrontation with the police on **29 September 1914** resulted in 19 passengers being killed in firing. The Komagata Maru incident served as a catalyst for the rise of the Ghadr Movement.

Bhagat Singh

(28 September 1907 - 23 March 1931)



- Born on **28 September 1907** in Lyallpur district, Punjab (now in Pakistan)
- One of the founders of Naujawan Bharat Sabha & Hindustan Socialist Republican Association
- Shot dead J.P. Saunders, Assistant Suptd. of Police, for the assault on Lala Lajpat Rai
- Caused a bomb explosion in the Central Legislative Assembly in Delhi in 1929 to protest the passing of the Trade Disputes Bill & Public Safety Bill
- His aim behind the harmless explosion was to "make the deaf hear"
- Sentenced to death along with comrades **Sukhdev Thapar & Shivaram Hari Rajguru**
- Died fearlessly on the gallows in Lahore Central Jail on **23 March, 1931**

Pritilata Waddedar
(5 May 1911 - 24 September 1932)



- An Independence activist born on 5 May 1911 in Chittagong, Bengal (now in Bangladesh)
- Joined a freedom fighter group headed by Surya Sen
- Led a team to attack Pahartali European Club, Chittagong - which symbolised the British supremacy
- Was shot in her leg ensuing a fierce gun battle during the attack
- Died on 24 September 1932 after consuming poison to avoid getting arrested
