Outcomes of Event: The students who participated gained some knowledge about the history, culture, diversity and integrity of our paired state Himachal Pradesh.

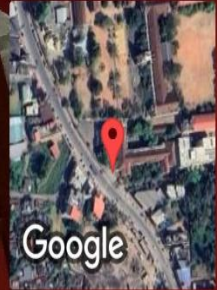
