Shimla, the capital city of Himachal Pradesh, was once the summer capital of British India. It’s named after Goddess Shyamala and is also known as Queen of Hills. Shimla is one of the few hillstations in India which are home to UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Some of the popular palces to visit in Shimla are The Ridge, Mall Road, Kalka-Shimla railway line, Kufri, Christ Church, Green Valley etc.
