4	<p><b>VISIT OF TOURIST DESTINATION BY MIGRATED STUDENTS:</b>The migrated students from Mahendragarh district of Haryana were taken on a tourist destination to Borra Caves located on the East Coast of India.in the Ananthagiri hills of the Araku Valley of the Visakhapatnam district in Andhra Pradesh.The caves ,one of the largest in the country .at an elevation of about 705m distinctly exhibit a variety of speleothems ranging in size and irregularly shaped stalactites and stalagmites.The caves are basically karstic limestone structures extending to a depth of 80m and are considered the deepest caves in India. Araku Tribal Museum was also shown to the Migrated students.It is a wonderful place which explores the tribal culture of Eastern Ghats.It is one of the top tourist places to visit in Araku Valley.Araku Tribal Museum is spread over two levels.built with mud and real metalsto portray tribal life.The museum has been designed to showcase tribal lifestyle in motion,starting with akitchen that displays utensils made of iron and mud.The most impressive section of the Tribal Museum is the onethat exhibits the local tribal Mayur and Dhimsa dance.The museum consists of several clay monuments that depict their day to day activities.Various artifacts of the tribal people are exhibited which includes jewellery ,hunting tools and kitchen utensils.There is a stall in the museum where handicraft items of the tribes are sold.</p>	12-6-2017
