HINDI ESSAY WRITING

In Hindi essay writing competition, 32 students participated. The senior students were given the topic “The Importance of Migration Policy in National Integration.” The students outlined the various benefits of migration policy, also referring to the success of the policy undertaken in Navodaya Vidyalayas. For juniors, the topic was “Speciality of Indian culture: Unity in Diversity.” The students wrote with coherence about the various dimensions at which the motto of Unity in Diversity is followed in India.
