A BRIEF REPORT ABOUT EVENT : Dadaria is one of various types of folk-songs or field song of the state of Chhattisgarh in India. These songs were very popular and part of folkore before the 1970s and were sung by village men or women while harvesting in paddy fields or during leisure. In the late 1980s, the singing of these songs by any man before a woman or women in private were considered to be socially unacceptable due to intimate language of these songs which had developed mostly as 'question and response' between a male - female duet.

- **REPORT OF THE EVENT** : As a part of 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat' programme our Vidyalaya has conducted the programme. Dadaria folk song is performed in JNV Mokokchung, Nagaland by the girls students. Before the song Principal inaugurated the programme by lightening of the lamp and CCA I/C briefed about the Dadaria Folk song. The participants of JNV Mokokchung, Nagaland have beautifully performed this Dadaria Folk Song under the supervision of Music teacher.
