RASIYA FOLK SONG OF JNV BISHNUPUR, MANIPUR
(Students of JNV BiJnor, U.P)

Rasiya (Epicurean) is a style of folk song of North India “Braj” region around Mathura, Agra, Alligrah .Rasiya song are sung in the regional Hindi dialect of “Brajabhasha” and are performed in a variety of style ranging from unpretentious women’s song to group performances by semiprofessional “Akharas” (Clubs) of men, who sing in a more elaborate style with sophisticated and varied poetic meters and texts on a wide range of topic.

Rasiya texts are typically amatory, often portraying the bashful country girls being teased by a man (the rasiya often implicitly Krishna, the playful cowherd God of Hindu Mythology). The migrated Students of JNV Bishnupur, presented the Rasiya folk Song in a group forming an “Akharas” on the Texts of précising the surrounding beauty of “Braja” and the happy moment of *Brajabashi* with the cowherd God Krishna.
