5. **Brief about the Event:**

With reference to the NVS RO Pune letter No: NVS (PR)/2017-18 dated 13-10-2017 and calendar of events the Cultural Exchange Programme between Home State & partening State (Gujarat & Madhya Pradesh) has been conducted in folk dance of Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh. The programme consisted of the performing art ie. Garbha dance of Gujarat that was performed by the migrated students of JNV Neemuch, MP and the Malwa (Matki) dance of MP that was performed by the local students of JNV Tapi.

GARBHA DANCE

Garba (ગરબા in Gujarati) is a form of dance which originated in Gujarat. The name is derived from the Sanskrit term *Garbha* which means womb and *Deep* which means a small earthenware lamp. Normally, traditional garbas are performed around a centrally lit lamp or a picture or statue of the Goddess Shakti. The circular and spiral figures of garba have similarities to other spiritual dances, such as those of Sufi culture. Traditionally, it is performed during the nine-day Hindu festival Navratri. Either the lamp (the *Garba Deep*) or an image of the Goddess, Durga (also called *Amba*) is placed in the middle of concentric rings as an object of veneration.

MALWA FOLK DANCE (MATKI)

This is a community dance of the *Malwa (Matki)* which is performed by women on various occasions in Madhya Pradesh. The dancers move rhythmically to the beating of a drum locally called *Matki*. Initiated by a lone woman locally called *Jhela*, others join dressed in their traditional *Malvi* wardrobe and with a veil covering their faces. The graceful hand movements and steps of the participants create a stunning effect.

6. Brief Report on the Programme.

With reference to the NVS RO Pune letter No: NVS(PR)/2017-18 dated 13-10-2017 and calendar of event the Cultural Exchange Programme between Home State & partening State has been conducted in folk dance of Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh.
