Brief about event

The migrated students of JNV Kanpur got an opportunity under **EBSB** programme to interact the farmers of Bijapur district and get acquainted the agriculture practices and traditional agriculture knowledge.

Interlink of agriculture practice at a glance:

It was a wonderful chance for the migrated students to study about the rural areas and prevalent agriculture practices of Bijapur district under the guidance of Principal, vice principal and concerned teachers. Students were taken to the village Benal and given exposure by the local farmers, information were gathered, students studied different soil texture, cropping pattern, methodology of agriculture practices further they could find the differences in crop density and irrigation methods which are quite different from the state Uttar Pradesh. When the students were asked what they want to carry from Bijapur to their own area , they replied – they want to adopt drip and sprinkle irrigation in place of open irrigation (practicing in UP) to preserve precious natural resource WATER.

In the next phase migration students taken to vidyalaya garden where they observed different type of vegetation , students enquired the differences of fruiting and ripening season of drumstick, pomogranets and sweet lime.

An artistic part of the programme was – India map was drawn depicting Uttar Pradesh full of greenery and wheat cultivation whereas Karnataka depicted as a raagi bowl of south India. The different states were shown in different colour shades to convey the message of UNITY IN DIVERSITY.

On the whole through, EBSB programme we could expose and enhance the culture and tradition of both states. The programme accomplished with Kajri dance of Uttar Pradesh which enlighten the local students and made them feel and respect the special feature of our nation, UNITY IN DIVERSITY.
