Also globally renowned for its textile bounded patterns & fabric locally called Baandhana.
4. Dhenkanal- Famous all over the world for its Dokra casting bell-metal horn work, straw work and tribal jewellery. The city contains the loftiest peak of Kapilash Range which has the ancient temple of Lord Shiva attracting tourists from all over India.
5. Kendrapada- The city contains the only marine wildlife sanctuary of Odisha called the 'Gahirmatha Wildlife Sanctuary' famous for Olive Ridley Sea Turtles located within the close vicinity of Bhitarkanika National Park famous for crocodile breeding.
6. Koraput- known as the mini Kashmir of Odisha. Also famous for its picturesque landscape and mesmerizing waterfalls which attract a lot of tourists round the year.
