DAY 1 (23rd Dec 2019)

On 22nd Dec I along with 34 other collegemates and 3 faculty members (Dr. Kirti Mam, Dr. Anuradha Mam and Mr. Sunil Sir) boarded the Sampark Kranti Express at around 11 pm. We reached to Kurnool City Station around 1 pm where we were cordially attended by 3rd year students of IIITDM Kurnool college Sai Teja and Joel.
