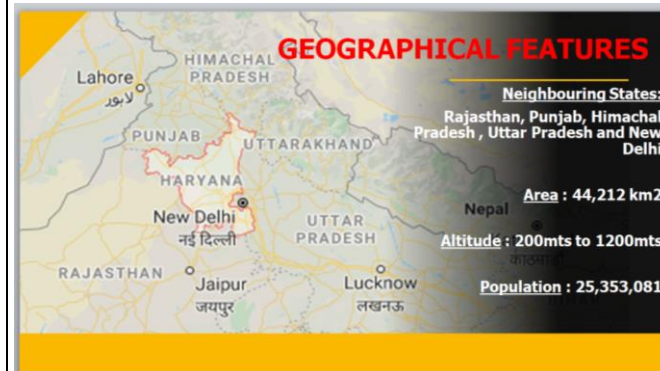

- Older women usually sing devotional Mangal Geet and ceremonial songs such as Bhajan, Bhat

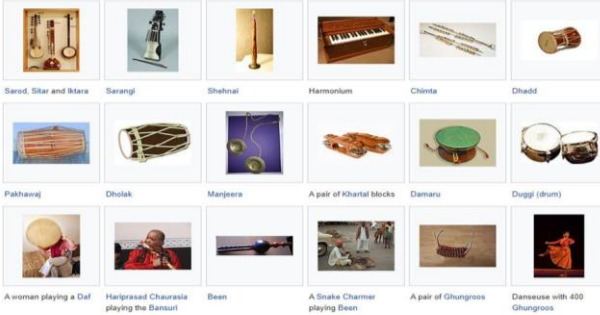

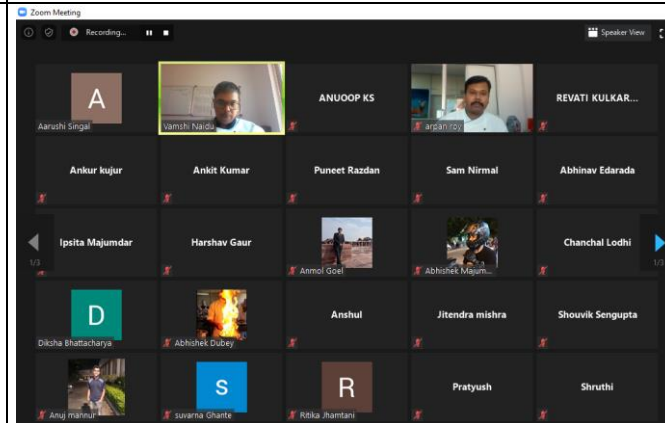
