Buy long-lasting products with minimal or no packaging to minimize the trash you generate.

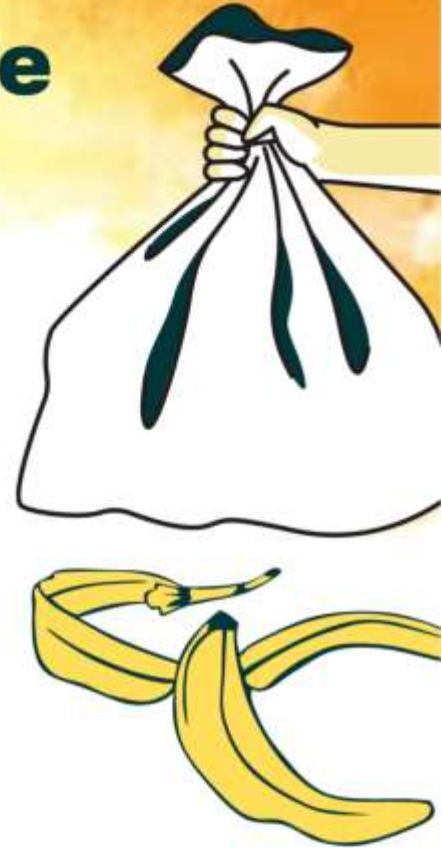
Step 2: Reuse.
