SAINIK SCHOOL REWARI A REPORT ON EK BHARAT SHRESHTH BHARAT EVENT- JULY 2022

1. Refer to Sainik School Bijapur letter no. SSBJ/237/EBSB/Trg dated 28 June 2022. 2. Two events were conducted in the month of July in the series of EBSB annual activities. 3. Detail of the events are as under: -

(a) **EVENT- 1 (i) PREPARATION OF TRADITIONAL DISH OF PARTNER STATE - ANDHRA PRADESH.** A special dinner of the food items of our partner state Andhra Pradesh was prepared in School Dining Hall on 29 Jul 2022 (Friday). Andhra Pradesh is known for its spices. The Andhra cuisine served in the dining hall comprised of both vegetarian and non-vegetarian dishes. The famous Hyderabadi dishes including Biryani, delectable Pulihora, Andhra Chicken Biryani, curd rice, pickle made with Ambadi leaves, Coconut chutneys, Papad etc were served to all the cadets Staff and the Officers.
