EK BHARAT SHRESHTH BHARAT – I CAMP NCC ACADEMY, MALOUT (04 JUN TO 15 JUN 2022)

- 1. India is a unique nation, whose fabric has been woven by diverse linguistic, cultural and religious threads, held together into a composite national identity by a rich history of cultural evolution coupled with a rousing freedom struggle. The idea of **Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB)**, a sustained and structured cultural connect between denizens of different regions was mooted by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi who propounded that cultural diversity is a joy that ought to be celebrated through mutual interaction & reciprocity between people of different States and UTs so that a common spirit of understanding resonates throughout the country.
- 2. To foster the spirit of Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat and solidarity amongst NCC cadets and to create awareness regarding diverse cultural heritage of our country highlighting the various aspects of unity in diversity Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat Camp I 2022 for NCC cadets of PHHP&C and B&J Dte was organized at NCC Academy Malout by NCC Dte PHHP & C, Chandigarh under the aegis of NCC Gp HQ, Patiala from 04 Jun to 15 Jun 2022, wherein 20 Punjab Bn NCC, Bathinda was the Nodal Unit for the conduct.
- 3. A total of 597 cadets to include 399 SD/ SW and 198 JD/ JW cadets from PHHP&C and B&J Dtes attended the camp. PHHP&C Dte was the Host Dte with 250 SD/SW cadets & 200 JD/JW cadets and B&J Dte was the Guest Dte with 150 SD/SW cadets. The duration of the **EBSB I Camp** for SD/ SW and JD/ JW cadets was 12 and 10 days respectively.
- 4. To celebrate the unity in diversity of our great nation and to promote respective state customs, traditions, culture and heritage, number of activities were conducted to include the 'State at a Glance' presentations by cadets of six participating States/ UT, Cultural activities to include Group Folk Dances and Songs, Language and Cuisine classes, visit of cadets of guest Dte to local village. - 7. The camp concluded with the closing ceremony which was graced by the Maj Gen Rajiv Chhibber, SM, ADG NCC Dte PHHP&C, Chandiagarh. A cultural programme showcasing the rich culture and tradition was performed by the cadets of both the State Dte's. The ADGgave away prizes to the cadets who had performed well during the camp. The ADG in inhis address to all Officers, Staff & Cadets highlighted the aim of EBSB camp and exhorted all cadets to be the torch bearers for strengthening the unique aspect of 'Unity in Diversity' of our great nation.
