

Report on administration of reading of the Constitution Day Preamble in the language of the partnering state under EBSB

Details of the Activities:

Constitution Day also known as 'Samvidhan Divas', is celebrated in our country on 26th November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26th November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution of India, which came into effect from 26th January 1950.

The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on 19th November 2015 notified the decision of Government of India to celebrate the 26th day of November every year as 'Constitution Day' to promote Constitution values among citizens.

The 26th November has its own importance in the history of independent India because on this day in 1949, the Constitution of India was adopted and it came in to effect on 26 January, 1950. Therefore, marking the dawn of a new era and to acknowledge the contribution of the framers of the Constitution, this day is celebrated as the 'Constitution Day' also known as Samvidhan Divas or National Law Day or National Constitution Day by a gazette notification in remembrance of the Father of Indian Constitution, Dr. B R Ambedkar every year.

Indian Institute of Management Visakhapatnam has celebrated the Constitution Day at 11:00 AM on 26th November, 2021, by reading the Preamble' and pledge. The occasion was celebrated in the premises of IIM Visakhapatnam in all its solemnity and was marked by the conduct of a 'Special Pledge Assembly' by the Director, Faculty members, Administrative Staff, of the Institute physically along with following the necessary SOP for CoVID-19 as issued/directed by the GoI.
