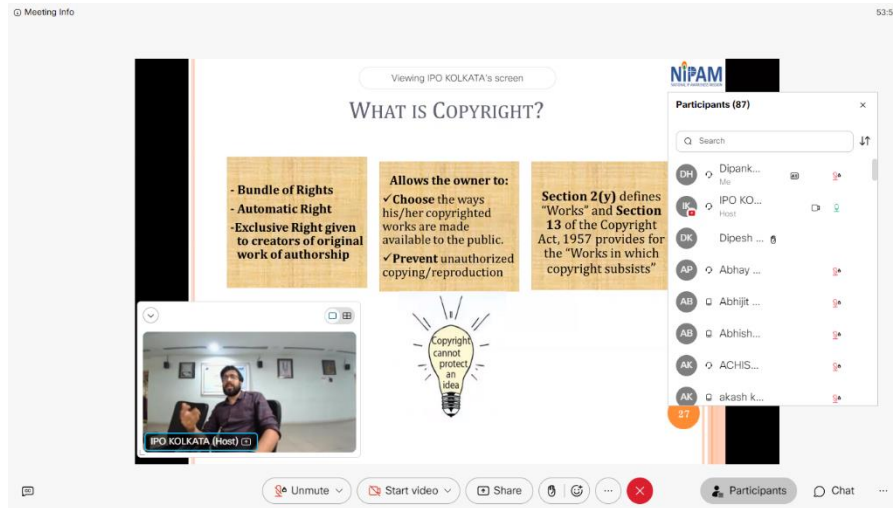

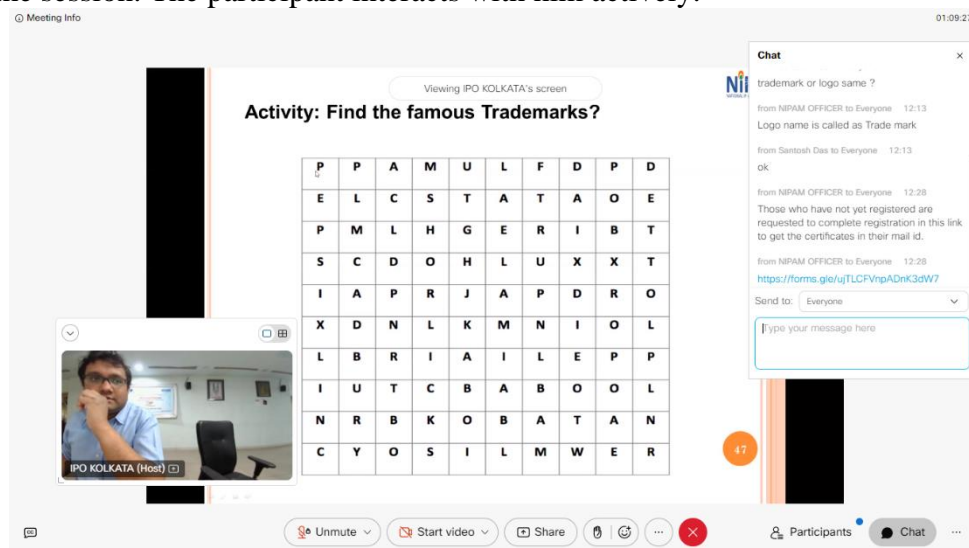

At first, Mr. Nikhil Ranjan presented different aspects of IPR with slide show and informative animation.

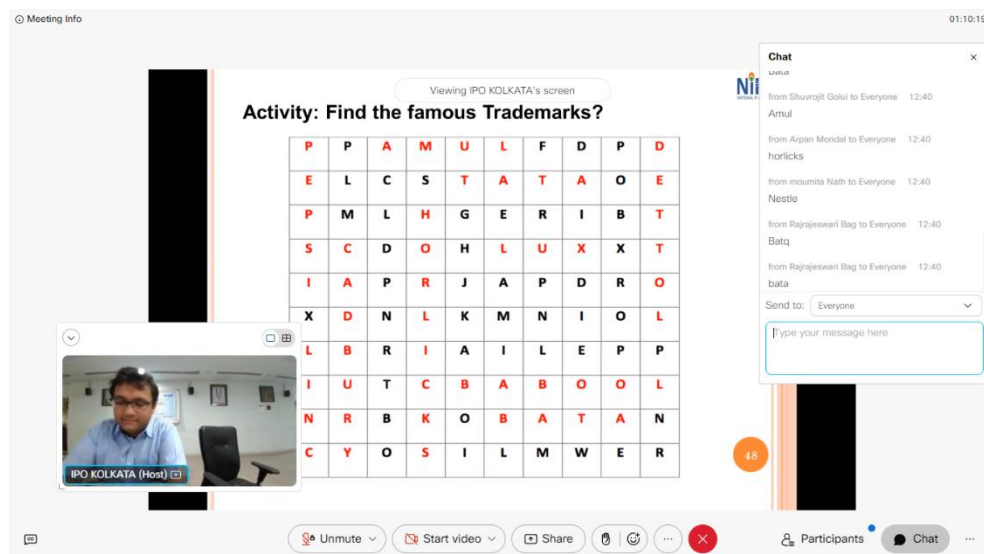


**Fig 1. Webinar presented by Mr. Nikhil Ranjan**
