- To share culture, tradition, Cuisines, Language and different practices between states thereby create better understanding and bonding between states.

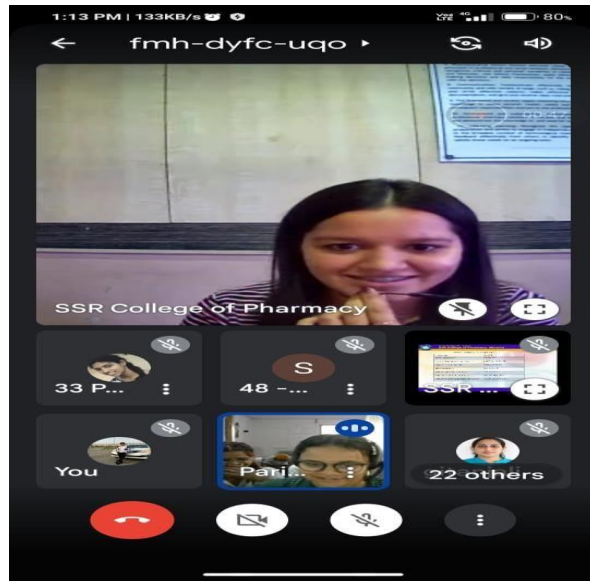
Reporting Period: 2nd March, 2022 to 15th March, 2022

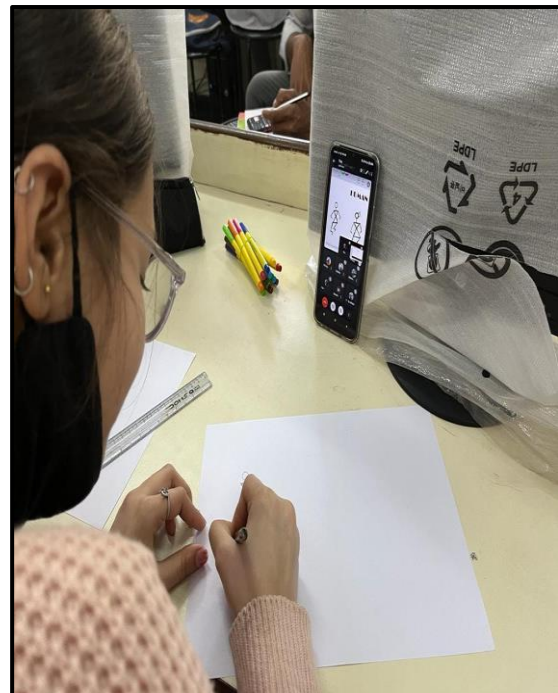
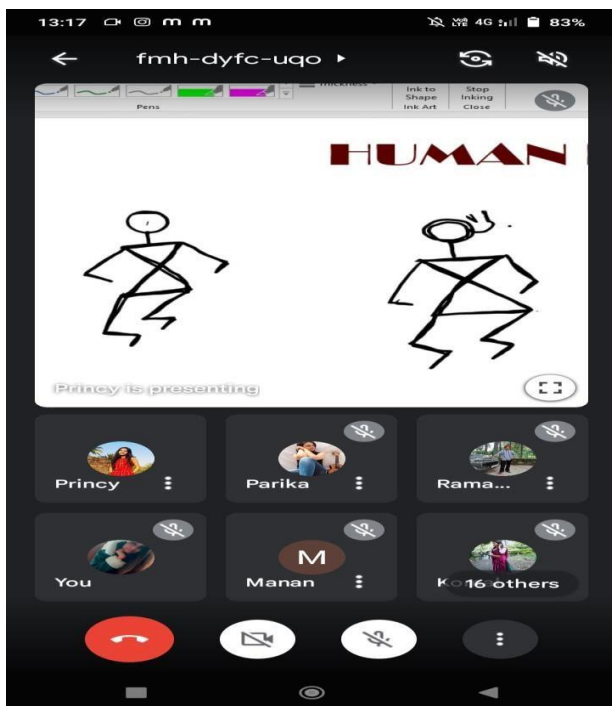
INTRODUCTION TO CHANDIGARH (DAY-5)
