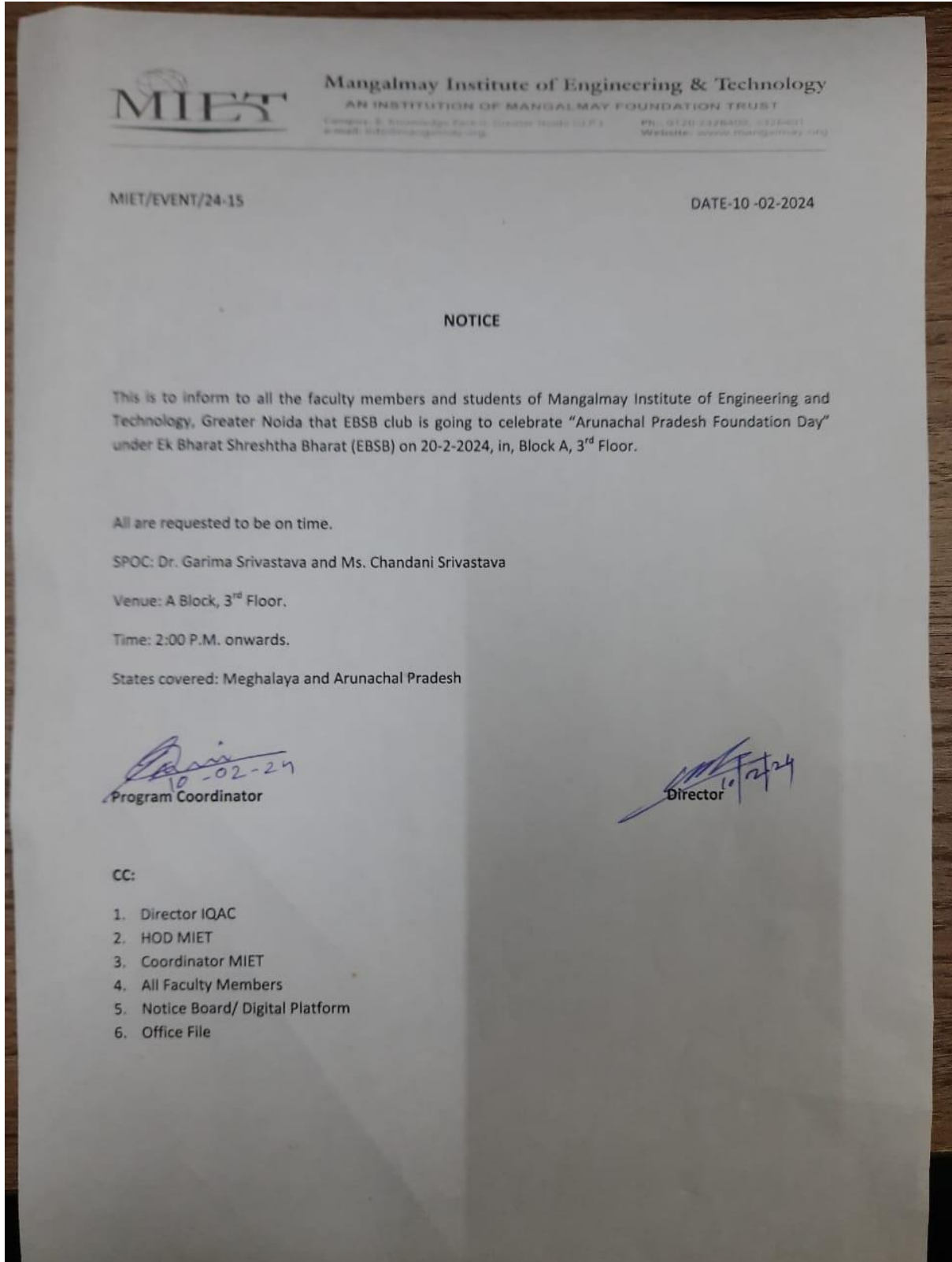

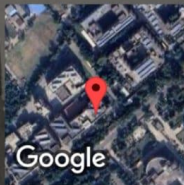

Prior to this, it was known as the North-East Frontier Agency (NEFA) and was administered as a Union Territory. The transition to statehood brought with it a greater degree of autonomy and representation for the people of Arunachal Pradesh. The session aimed to promote cultural exchange, unity, and understanding among participants in pairing states i.e Arunachal Pradesh and Meghalaya. The session commenced with an introduction to the cultural diversity of Arunachal Pradesh, highlighting its significance in the Indian cultural landscape. 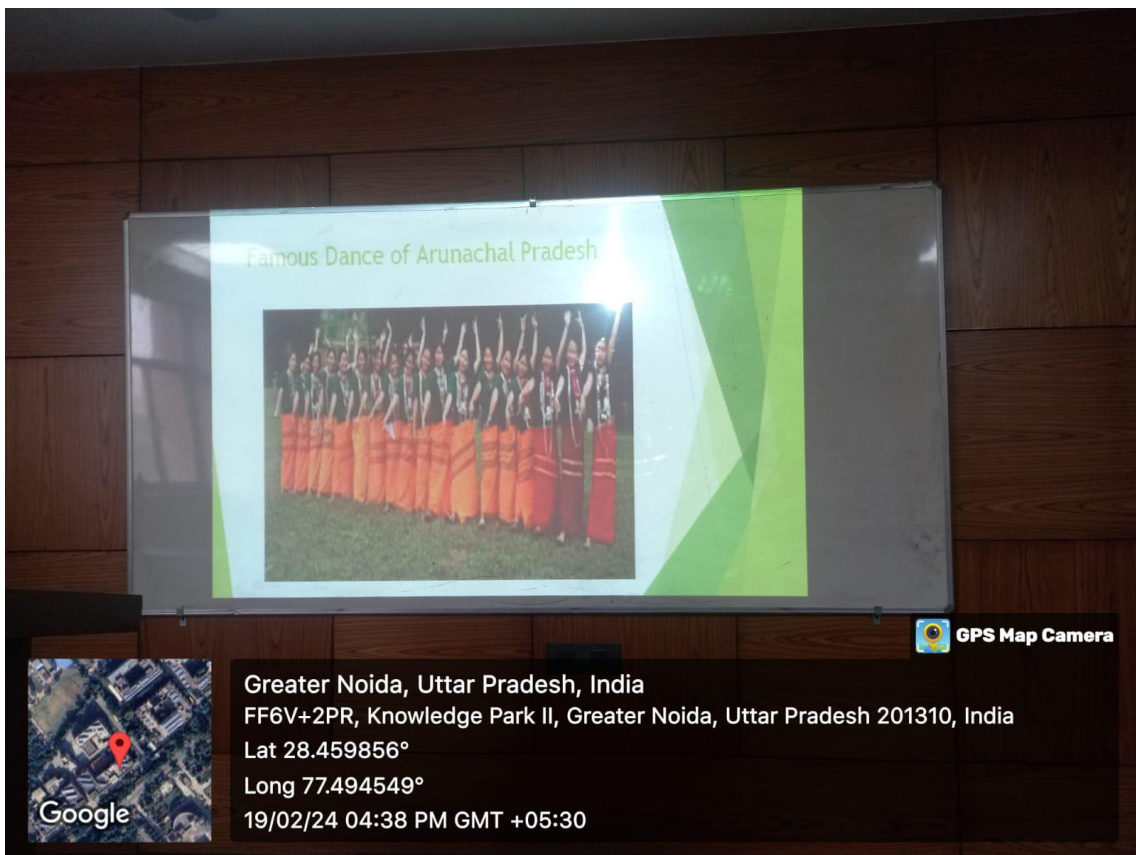
