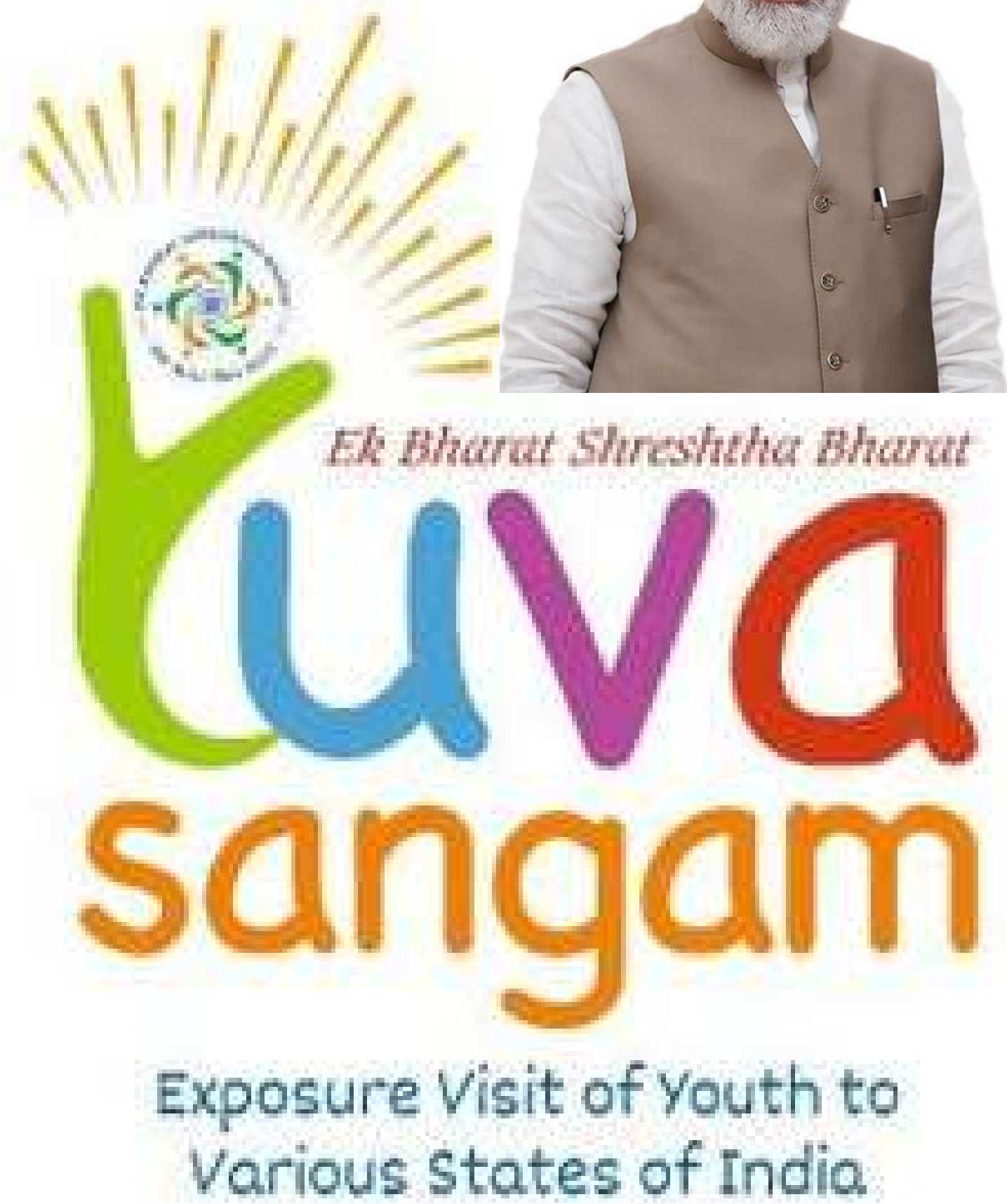

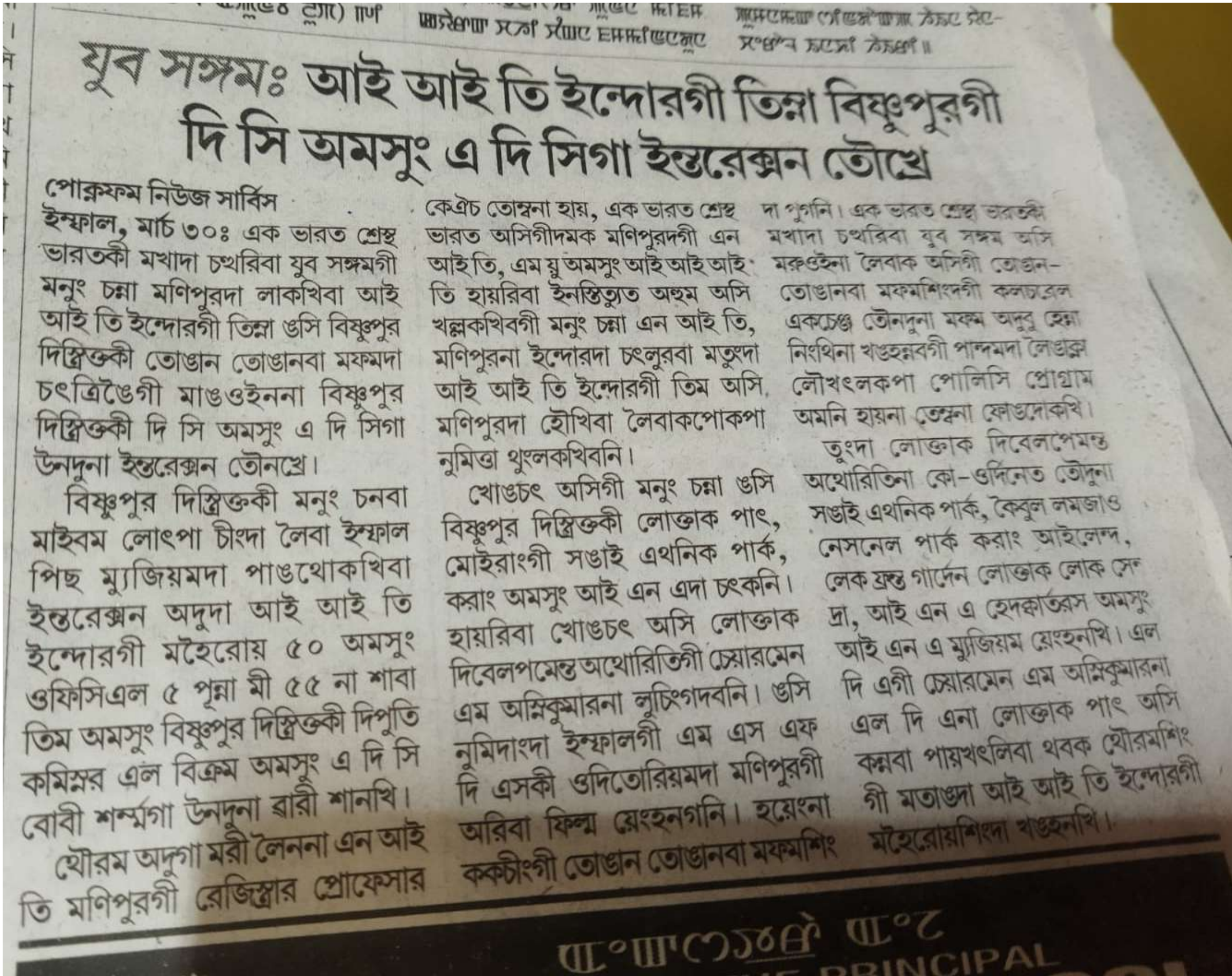

IIT INDORE STUDENTS ACCORDED GRAND WELCOME AT NIT MANIPUR CAMPUS

Under the 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Yuva Sangam' programme, a government of India initiative, a group of students from IIT Indore from across the districts of Madhya Pradesh were accorded a grand welcome at the Bir Tikendrajit International Airport by officials and students of NIT Manipur. The students of IIT Indore were overwhelmed by the reception accorded to them by NIT Manipur and students. A team of 49 students from Madhya Pradesh reached Imphal (Manipur) on Monday to encourage interaction and dialogue between Madhya Pradesh and Manipur. The team also comprised of 26 boys and 23 girls and 6 officials of IIT Indore. The team will stay in Manipur till April 2 to understand and explore the rich culture and tradition of Manipur. Students from about 25 districts of Madhya Pradesh are included in this team. The emphasis will be on increasing the exchange of rich cultural and traditional and ideas between the two states through this visit. Along with this, emphasis will also be laid on promotion of tourism, tradition, progress, technology and mutual contact. IMPHAL: Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat programme of Government of India is gaining popularity and achieving its objective which is being felt in Manipur where 55 strong contingents comprising students and faculties from Madhya Pradesh are at present on a tour of the Northeastern state.

The contingent is led by the members of Indian Institute of Technology, Indore and is being hosted by National Institute of Technology, Manipur. On Thursday the visiting students of MP got to experience the Imphal Peace Museum, Sangai Ethnic Park, Keibul Lamjao National Park, and Loktak Lake in Karang, INA Museum.

M. Asnikumar Singh, Chairman of Loktak Development Authority was present and interacted with the visiting team while the Deputy Commissioner of Bishnupur district Lourembam Bikram addressed the students at Imphal Peace Museum and answered various questions from the students. M.



Asnikumar while addressing the students at the office of Loktak Development Authority in Loktak said that Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat is a visionary programme started by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and is serving its objective of uniting the people.

He welcomed the team from MP and wished the young mind to explore the rich heritage and culture of Manipur. Being an environmentalist Asnikumar passionately highlighted the value of Loktak Lake. He echoed that Loktak Lake is the cra-

dle of Manipur's civilization.

Appreciating PM Modi he stated that PM Modi had visited Loktak before he became Prime Minister and has taken note of its challenges and its value and now we are in the process of building the ecosystem of the lake and has approached Asian Development Bank for Technical and financial assistance which is also being wholeheartedly supported by the Government of Manipur and is being taken up as a Mission mode project under the leadership of Chief Minister N.

Biren Singh. He said the lake is a threatened one due to many man made challenges and unplanned development for last forty years but now they are going to rejuvenate the whole lake under the leadership of PM Modi. Asnikumar wished all the students to take the leadership of achieving the objective of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat and wished them luck in their future endeavors.

Later the students visited the INA War Museum and newly transformed INA Headquarters where they were given a guided tour. The students were emotionally attracted to the fact that INA soldiers unfurled the INA flag in 1944, and gave the slogan Netaji Subhas Amar rahe!

In the evening the members of the visiting delegation were taken to Manipur State Film Development Society where the Secretary Sunzu Bachaspatimayum gave a historic perspective of Manipuri cinema as well as a guided tour of the newly started archive.

A critically acclaimed film Eikhoigi Yum was screened for the visiting delegation.

Mainland Indians visit less to NE Region: Dr. Dhabali

IMPHAL: A team of fifty five strong contingent including students and faculties of Indian Institute of Technology, Indore is on a 5 days tour to Manipur hosted by National Institute of Technology Manipur under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat programme of Government of India where students are exposed to various iconic sites of the state and culture.

In one of the programme the students and visiting members were addressed by Manipur's leading industrialist Dr. Th. Dhabali Singh, the CMD of BABINA Group of Companies who presented a short historical background of the culturally rich state of North East India.

While speaking about tourism potential of Manipur, he first sensitised the global scenario and informed the young audience that tourism contributes 13.9% of world's GDP, generates employment for 311 million i.e. 11.8% of world's total employment. He echoed

the tourism sector provides one in twelve jobs in the world. He stated that the tourism sector is the largest job provider in the country with 79.86 million direct and indirect jobs as of FY 2020. It is projected to expand to US \$ 125 billion by 2027 according to FICCI estimates.

Explaining the Indian tourism market he stated that 31.4 million foreign tourists visited India in 2019 and 2321 million domestic tourist visits were made across India. However, it is seen that in 2016 Northeast recorded 77.13 Lakh domestic tourist visits which is only 0.47 of the total domestic traffic. Further he echoed that these data shows that mainland Indians visit less to the NE region.

Encouraging why one should visit Northeast India, Dr. Dhabali stated that NE India is a relatively unexplored paradise, it has different cultures, tribes, languages and food with a heavenly scenic beauty, amazing unique destinations. Northeast is now quickly becoming India's hot-



test destination. PM Modi also believes that NE India has huge potential, stated Dr. Singh. He informed that the Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned sixteen new projects worth 1300 crore in 2022.

Dr Singh also explained that with better infrastructure tourist inflow has increased in Manipur over the past years and 1.67 Lakh domestic tourist as well as 12000 foreign tourist has visited Manipur in 2019. He says that earlier Foreign tourist visits were only around

400 and this increase of almost 300% growth is visible due to lifting of restrictions for foreign tourists to the state of Manipur by the Union Home Ministry as well as availability of better infrastructures..

Dr. Dhabali believes that Manipur has lots of potential to grow in the Tourism sector as it has the connectivity which is one of the best in NE India and within the coming two years even the Rail connectivity will reach Imphal. Manipur offers some good exotic destinations,

a exotic food trail, natural and wildlife sites, adventure tourism sites, world War II trails as 50 thousand soldiers were killed during the war,

To promote tourism, Dr. Singh believes that we need to change the perception about NE India from a disturbed region to a progressive one and brand building exercise is the need of the hour. 'I think we require a brand ambassador to promote our state', he says.

A mesmerising cultural program was showcased by the students of JN Dance Academy which the visiting students of IIT Indore along with their faculties wholeheartedly cheerfully enjoyed..

Speaking at the sideline of the event Dr. Dhabali Singh said that this unique programme of 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat' is going to be a game changer for Manipur's tourism growth as the students will take fond memories home and the region's perception shall slowly change from negativity to that of a hot destination.

IIT Indore students accorded warm welcome

Under the 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Yuva Sangam' programme which is a Government of India initiative, a group of students from IIT Indore and from across the districts of Madhya Pradesh were accorded a grand welcome at the Imphal Airport by the officials and students of NIT Manipur.

It was the place where Lord Krishna and his brothers took their formal education

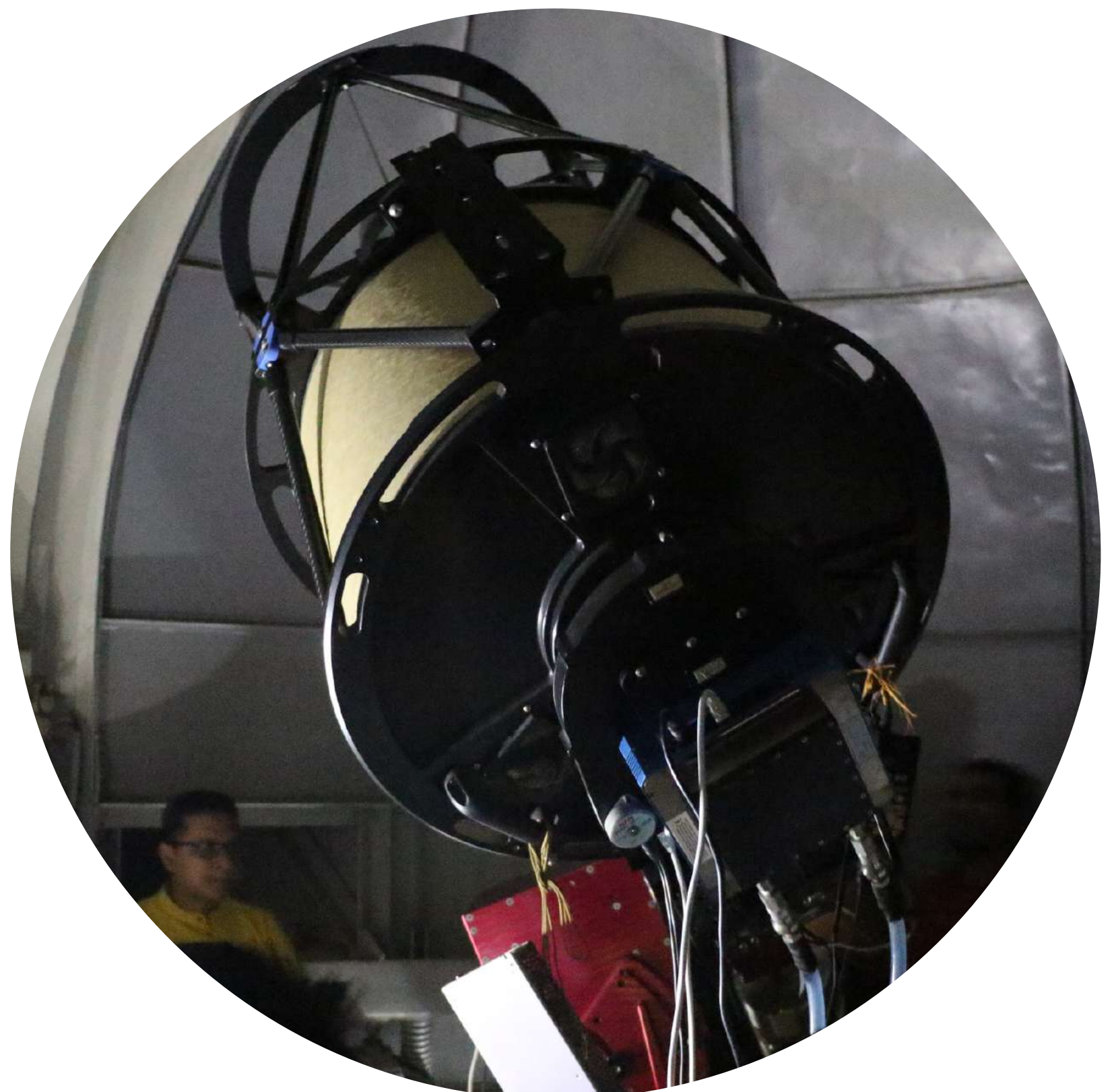


Visit to Maharishi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Prathisthan
