This webinar was a joint EBSB activity for Nirmala College Ranchi and Carmel College Goa

The Webinar was held on 8th October 2020 from 10:15am to 11:30 am on Google meet platform and was also be streamed live on Carmel College Youtube Channel.

The Webinar commenced with a short inaugural ceremony at 10:15am, a welcome address by the Principal, Nirmala College Ranchi Dr. Sr. Jyoti, and principal of Carmel College Goa Dr. Aldina Braganza, followed with a session by Associate Professor Louise Ann Sequeira, who enlightened the young audience about human rights, especially the rights of women through the Convention on Elimination of all forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW) and thus empower them to play a significant role in society.
