Report on EBSB Day for the month of Sept'2020

Date: 30th Sept, 2020

The EBSB Day for the month of September was organized on 30th Sept, 2020. The theme for the EBSB Day poster making competition on -

“RAJASTHAN TOURISM”

Since the state of Assam is paired with Rajasthan and so is IIT Guwahati with IIT-Jodhpur under this initiative of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat, Govt. of India, so through various monthly activities we are trying to glorify any aspect of the state of Rajasthan and this time it was about the tourism sector.

The rules of the competition were such that the students need to first register themselves by submitting their details in a google form. The e-poster was either submitted in pdf format or jpeg format. The aspect ratio was chosen as 2:3 and they were allowed to make the posters either in a digital format or on hard paper. However plagiarism from any source was strictly prohibited and we also strictly mentioned that if found guilty the candidature of such participants will be directly cancelled. The participants submitted their e-posters on the mentioned e-mail id within a stipulated time duration. The total number of students who registered for the event were 15 and the participants were from all curriculums.

The competition was judged by Mr. Paresh Saikia, hon'ble Vice-President of Jorhat Fine Arts Society who is also a retired employee of CSIR-NEIST, Jorhat. He completed his 5 years Art Education in Painting from Government College of Art, Guwahati, Assam, with Govt. Merit Scholarship and his research work in painting at Rashtriya Lalit Kala Kendra, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, under Research Grant Award instituted by Lalit Kala Akademi, New Delhi. Mr. Saikia also received Cultural Fellowship from Department of Culture, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India. His paintings are exhibited at many national and also international exhibitions including at Picassomio Gallery, Barcelona, Spain.

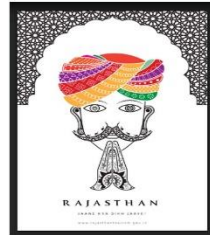

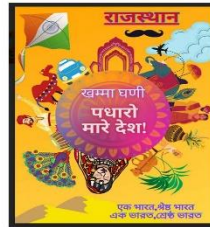

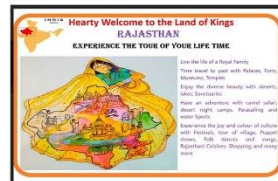


