Report on EBSB Day for the month of July'2020

Date: 31st July, 2020

For the EBSB Day observation in the month of July, we organized an online essay writing competition. The online essays were collected in a stipulated time duration and were then submitted to the judges. The online essay competition saw a very good participation among the students. All of them were quick to register for the competition and we are really glad to share that we received registration from exactly 101 students. We kept the theme of the essay competition and the topic of the essay competition was-

“Contribution of Rajasthani culture in Indian Cinema”

The rules of the online essay competition were such that the participants first need to register themselves by submitting a google form where they need to enter their details and after that only they were allowed to participate in the competition. The word limit was not more than 2000 words and both the docx/pdf formats were acceptable. However, since the electronic devices of the students at their respective homes was not assured due to the pandemic so we also provided the leeway to submit the scanned copies of their essays written on paper format and that was also accepted. We also strictly highlighted the point of “Plagiarism” and specifically mentioned that if any such plagiarism is noticed then the candidature of the participants will be liable to be disqualified. A time limit was also bounded for the participants and they have to submit their essays exactly under the stipulated time duration.

The students accordingly submitted their essays through email in the stipulated time and all the essays were collected. The competition was judged by three esteemed judges, namely Dr. Rajshree Bedamatta (Associate Professor, Dept of Humanities, IIT-Guwahati), Dr. Debapriya Basu (Assistant Professor, Dept of Humanities, IIT-Guwahati) and Dr. Kiran Keshavamurthy (Assistant Professor, Dept of Humanities, IIT-Guwahati). We are really grateful to all the three judges for their help, valuable suggestions and precious time. We also thanked all the students who took part in this competition. Especially a few of them had even left their electronic devices at some other places but still managed to submit their handwritten essays on time. We acknowledged everyone’s efforts and assured them that a participation certificate will be provided to all the participants. The winners of the online essay writing competition were announced by the Hon’ble Director of IIT-Guwahati during the Independence Day celebration at IIT-Guwahati, which was later on shared on Youtube along with the video of the announcement. The first prize was awarded to Dipisha Sawoo, 2nd year M.Sc student from Dept. of Chemistry. The second prize was awarded to Priya Chaturvedi, 3rd Semester B.Tech student from the Dept. of Chemical Science & Technology and the third prize was jointly awarded to Aditi Bhatt, 2nd year M.Des student from Dept of
