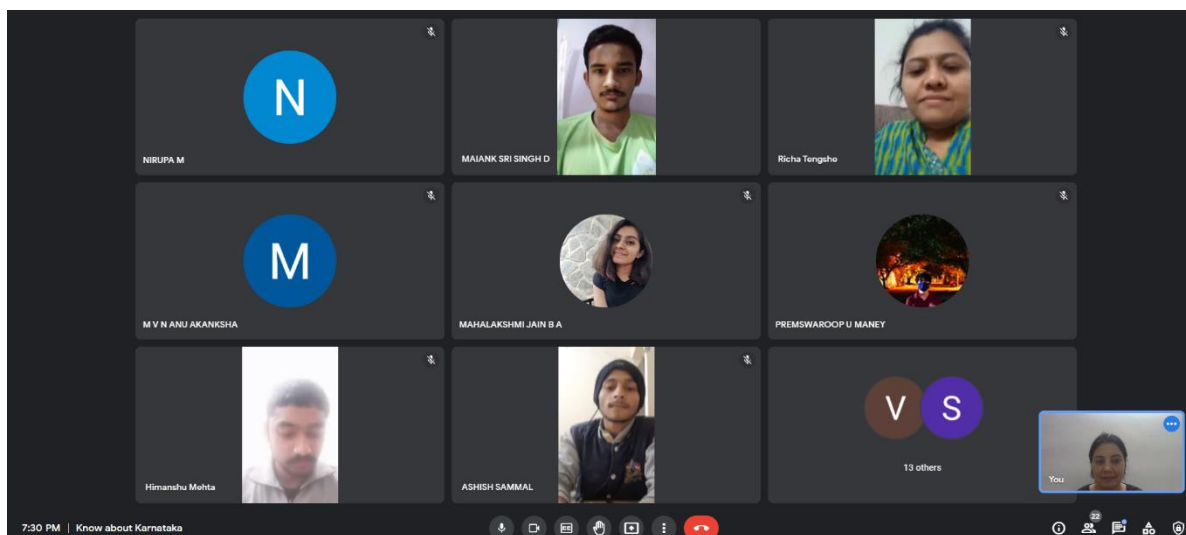

### HISTORY

- ◆ In the ancient times, KARNATAKA was known as 'KUNTALA DESA' consisting of enterprises which had trade connections with the Egyptians, Sumerians and other countries.
- ◆ There are also evidences to relate communication between KARNATAKA and the Indus Valley Civilization, such as the gold artifacts discovered in HARAPPA which seem to have been imported from the gold mines in KARNATAKA.
- ◆ By the advent of 4th century B.C., KARNATAKA had become a part of the Mauryan Empire.
- ◆ Then came the Satavahans, Kadambas, Gangas, Chalukyas, Rashtrakutas.
- ◆ By the end of the 10th century, the Yadavas of Devagiri, the Kalachuris of Kalyani and the Hoysalas of Dwarasamudra came to power.
- ◆ In the early 14th century, Harihara and Bukka Raya established the legendary Vijayanagara empire with Hoysattana (later named as Vijayanagara) as its capital, on the banks of the Tungabhadra River in the modern Bellary district of KARNATAKA.
- ◆ By the 16th century, new dynasties such as Nayakas, Paleyogars and Wodeyars started coming up which were eventually subdued by HAIDER ALI and his son, TIPPU SULTAN then became the ruler of Mysore.




