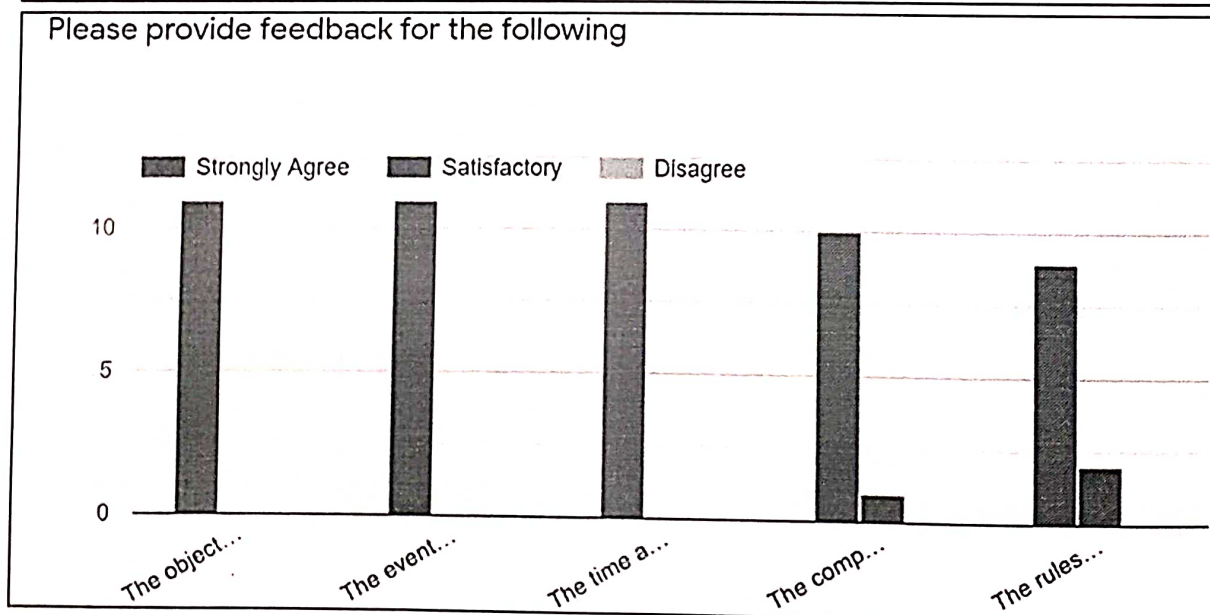
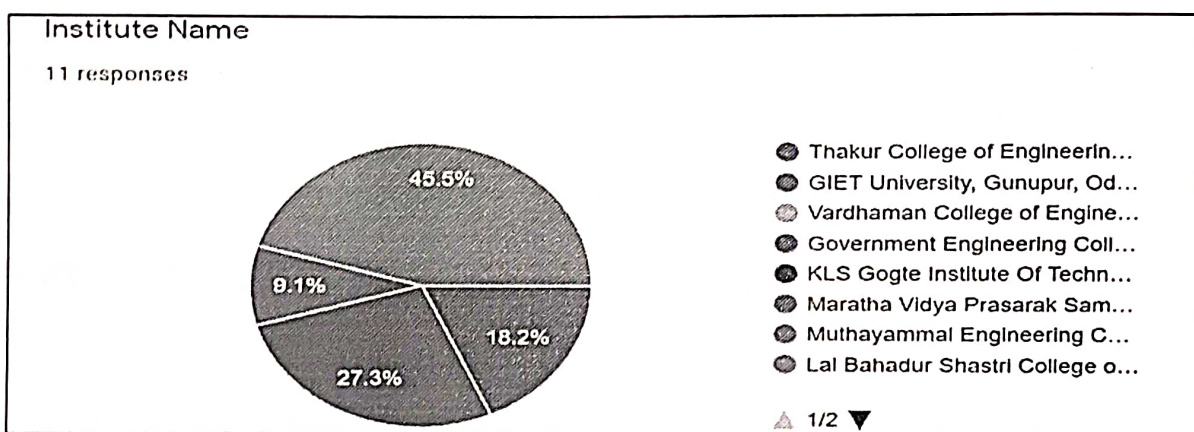

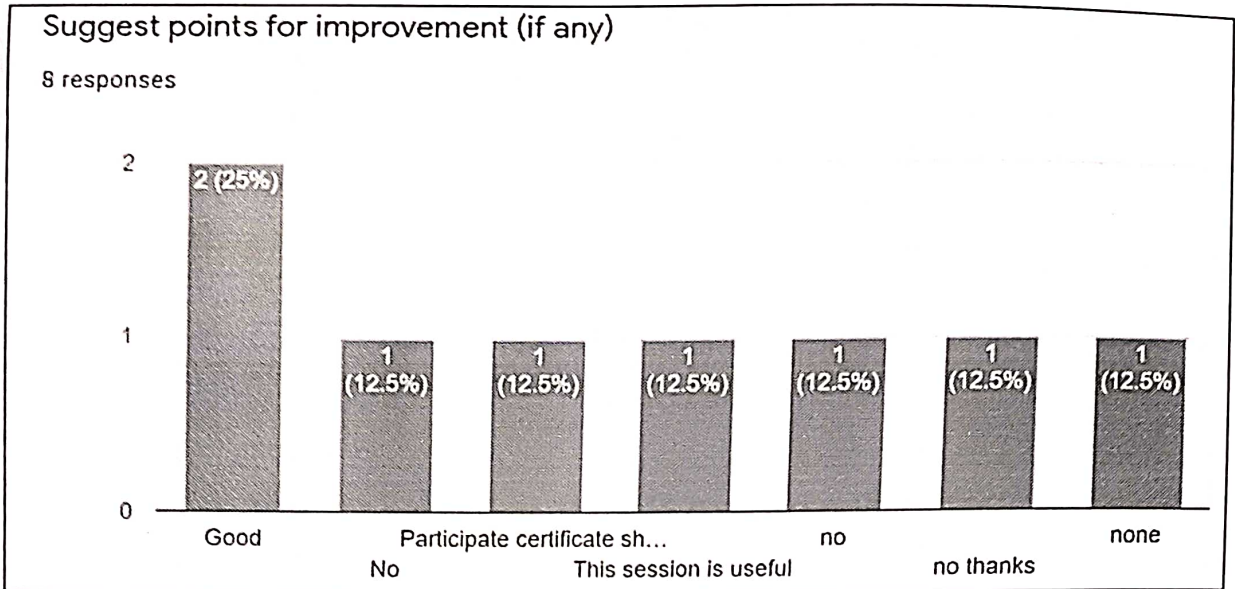

A total 11 feedback were received overall for the Poster Making & Essay Writing Competition. Feedback analyses are as follows:

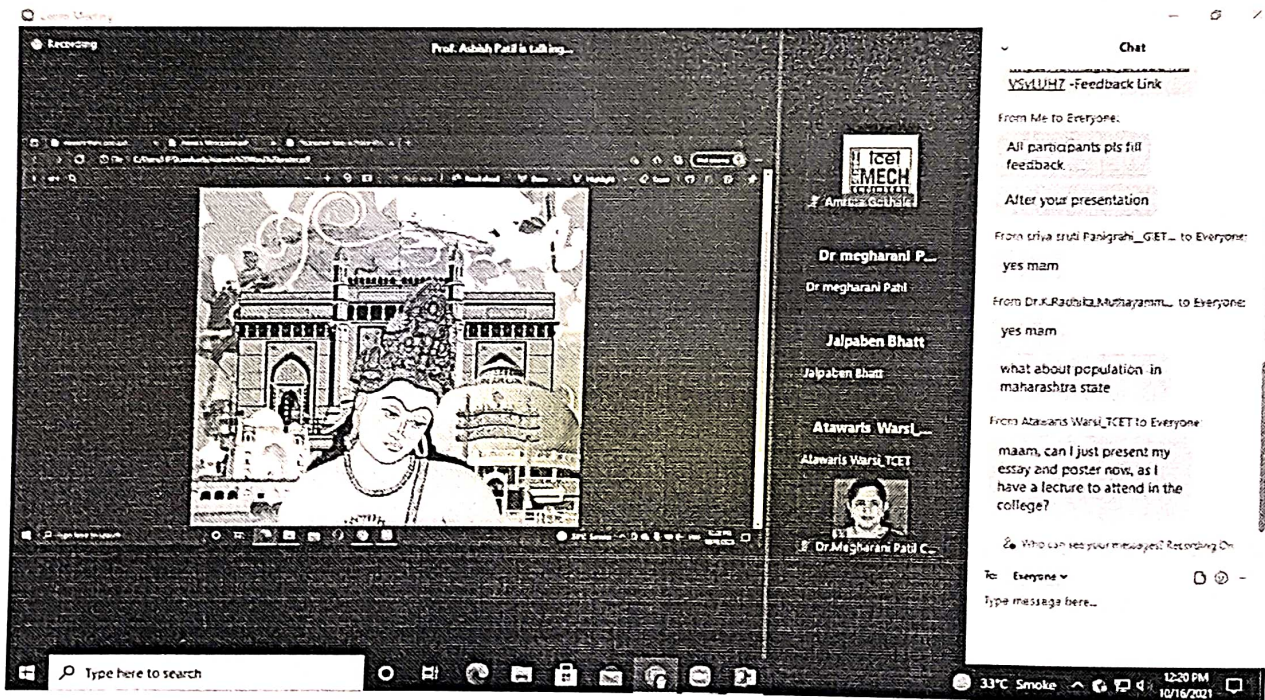




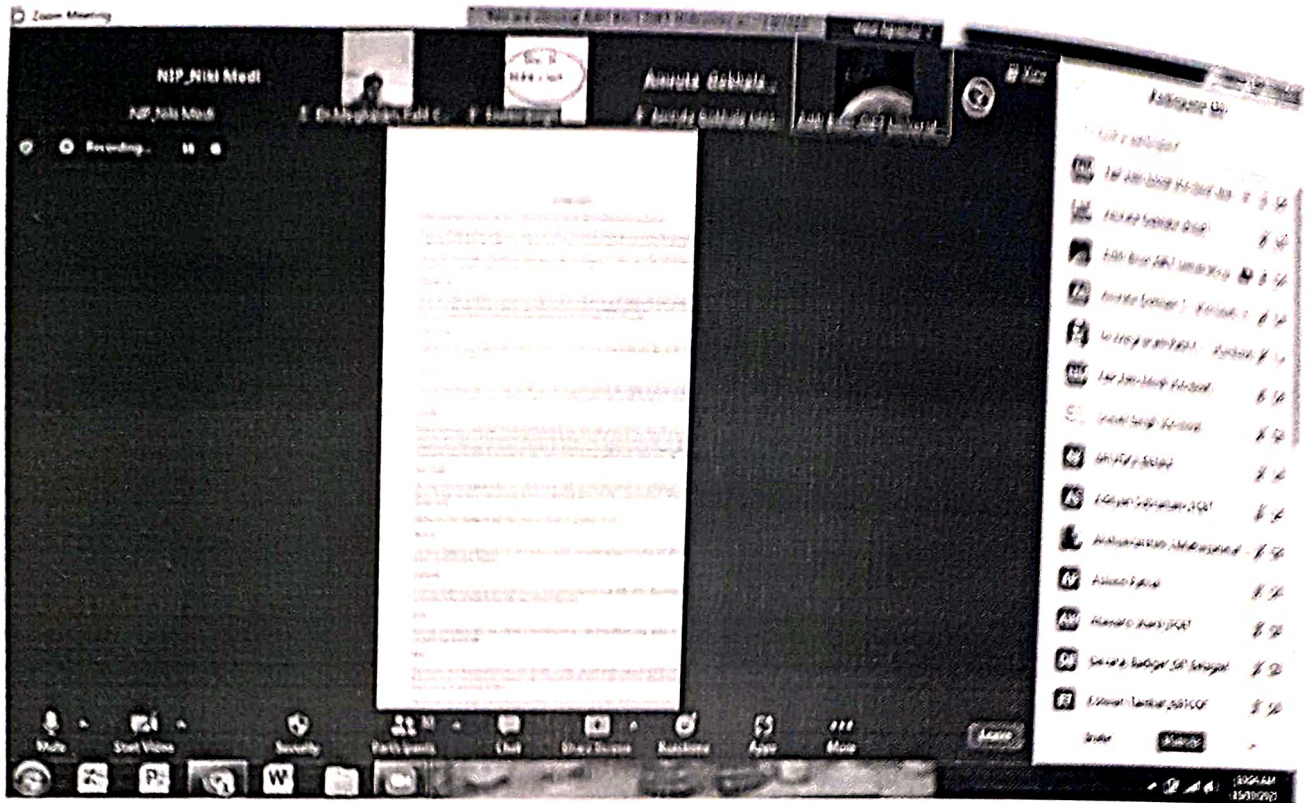

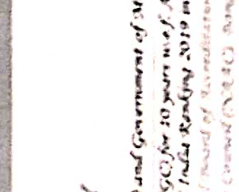
