Event description:

Government engineering college Valsad has organized pledge & quiz event under Ek Bharat Shresth Bharat program. Under this event students and faculties of all departments were invited to participate and take pledge of “Swachhata” & “NO Plastic Use”. EBSB club of GEC Valsad has selected some faulty & Students as coordinators to manage the event. They have been provided with the Xerox copy of “Swachhata” & “NO Plastic Use “pledge on a day before the event.

All department students have participated in event and taken oath on Swachhata and no use of plastic. Also EBSB club chairperson has informed students about demerits of use & throws plastics which harm the environment which leads to pollution of land, water and air.
