Guest Lecture by Dr. Rajendra Singh - Waterman of India Date: 06/02/2020

A guest lecture is organized for the students and faculties by MET's Institute of Engineering. The speaker for the lecture is Dr. Rajendra Singh is an Indian water conservationist and environmentalist from Alwar district, Rajasthan in India. Also known as "waterman of India", he won the Magsaysay Award in 2001 and Stockholm Water Prize, an award known as "the Nobel Prize for water" in 2015.
