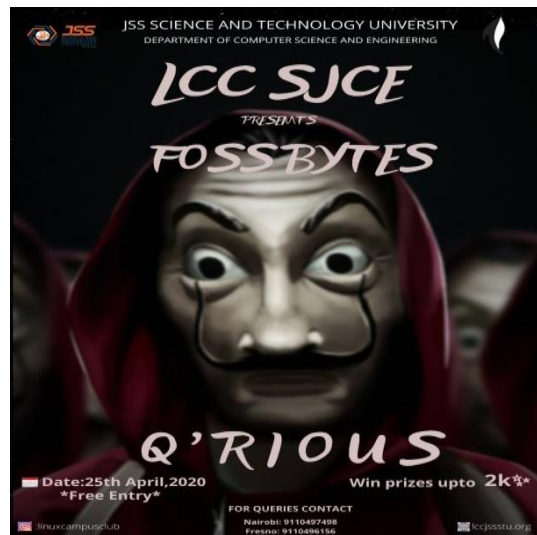

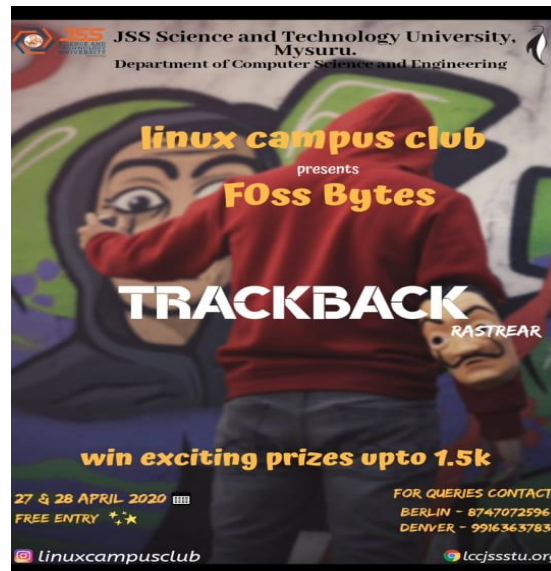

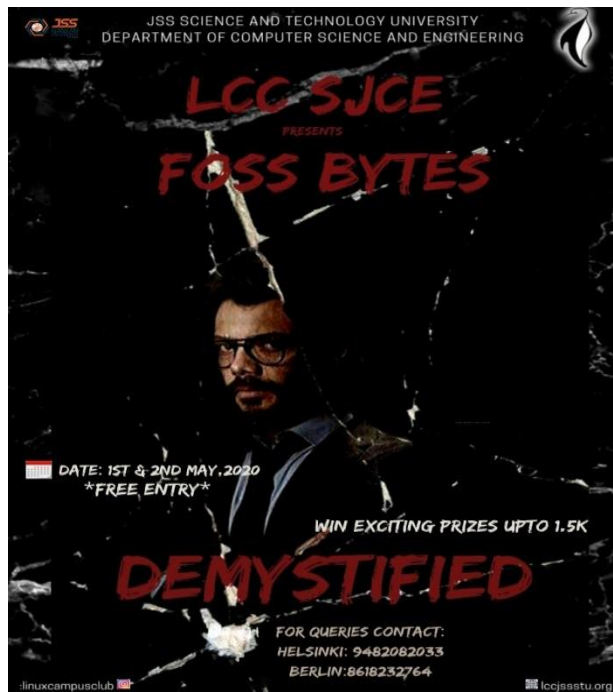

Date: 1st May – 2nd May

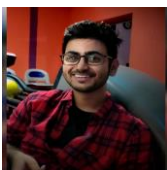

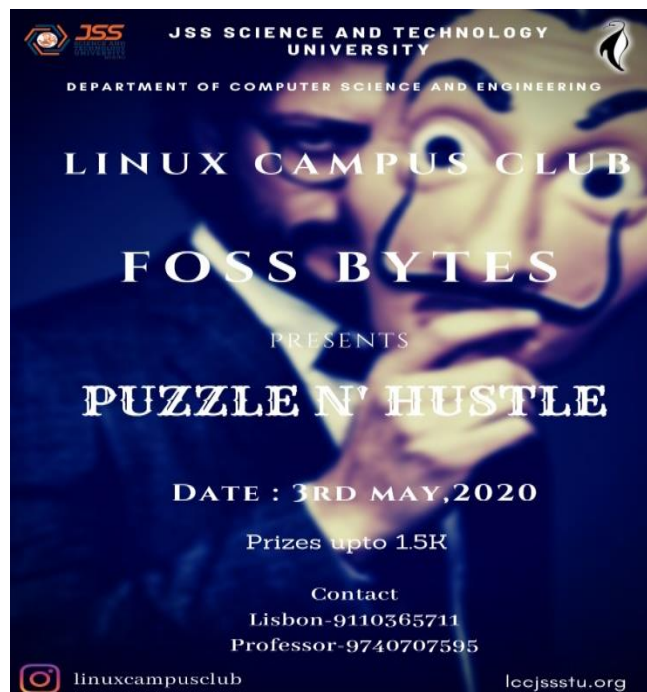
