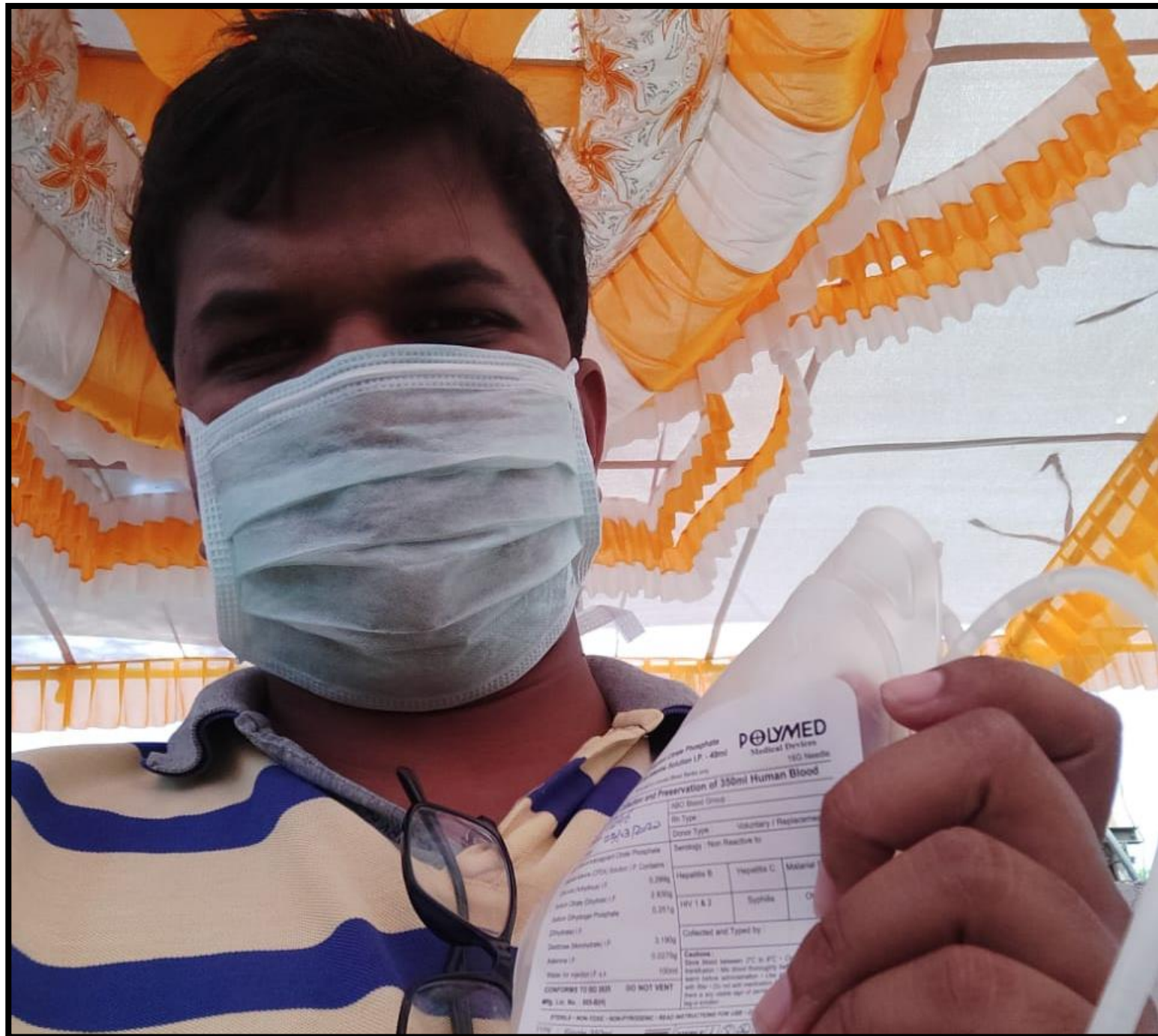
The Indian government announced lockdown suddenly to prevent the spread of COVID-19. As a result, many people are in financial distress. At times there is a problem of getting two square meals.
