- To share culture, tradition, Cuisines, Language and different practices between states thereby create better understanding and bonding between states.

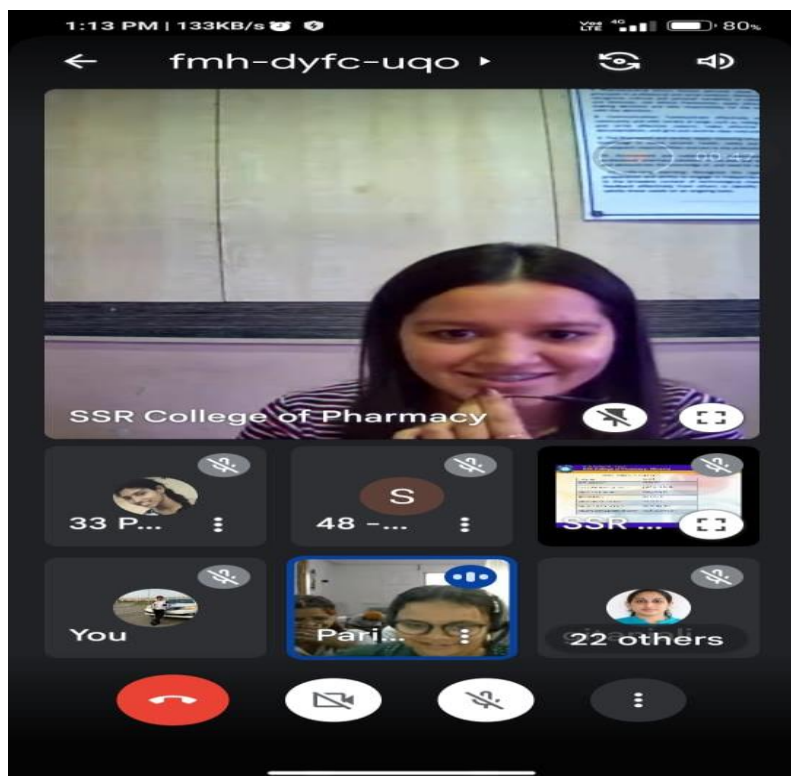
Reporting Period: 2nd March, 2022 to 15th March, 2022.

INTERACTION OF CLUB MEMBERS (DAY1)- A student club is formed by both the colleges and interactive session was held on the first day.

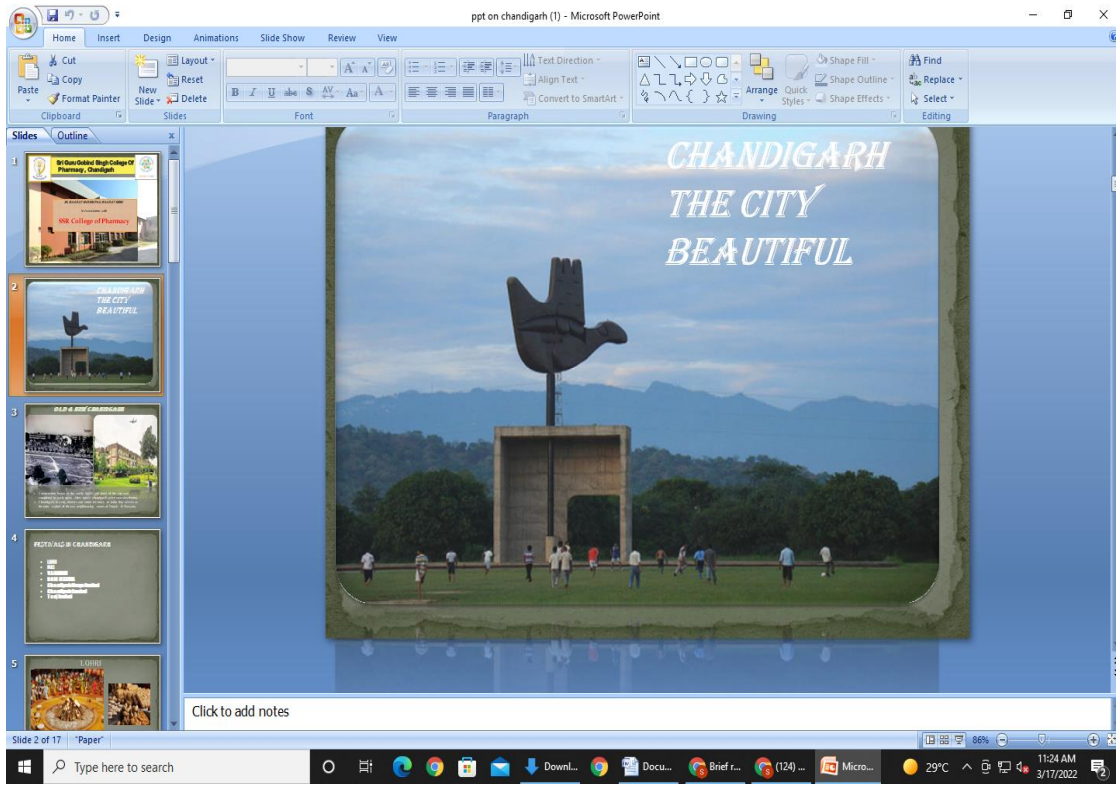


INTRODUCTION TO DADAR AND NAGAR HAVELI (DAY-3)

A PowerPoint presentation was presented by the SSR college of Pharmacy Silvassa, highlighting the key features of Dadar and Nagar Haveli.

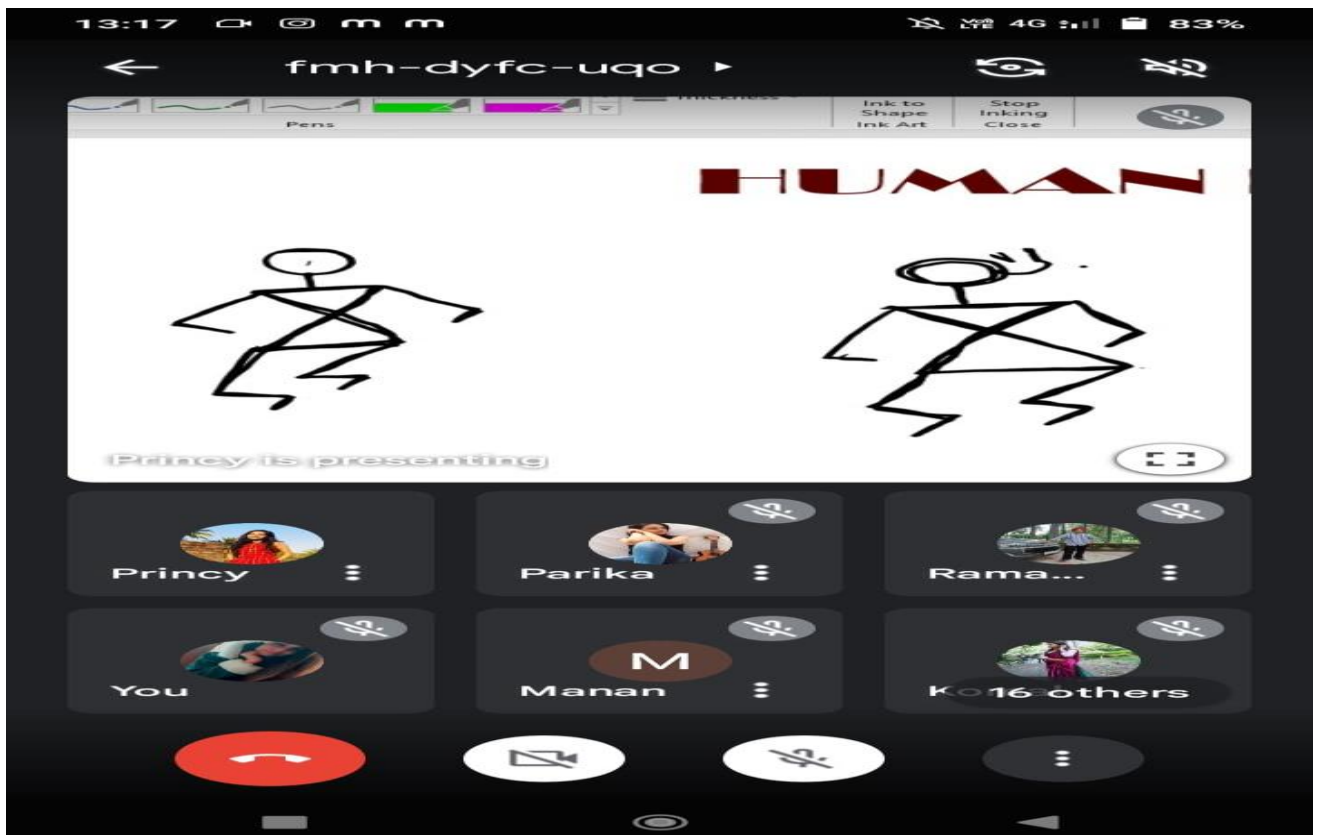
