This is the remarkable year as our College has been accredited as A++ Grade by NAAC. Fine Arts Association has contributed its own part during the NAAC Peer Team Visit and Team very much complimented the team for the performance staged.

As usual, the Association trained its members to nurture their talents to bring laurels to this great temple of learning. Our Teams have won many overall championship trophies and cash awards in National and State level cultural meets. The Association is very grateful to our beloved Fr. Principal and Fr. Secretary for having sectioned a considerable amount to purchase new guitar for music team, Folk team properties, and new costumes for both Dance and Theatre teams. We have convened 32 meetings totally to plan out regular activities in the College and Inter College Cultural Events. The detailed activities are reported below.

# **IUG ORIENTATION PROGRAMME**

The elections of Students council 2019-20 was conducted on 21st June 2019. The Nomination Papers to the candidates were issued from the College Office between 8.00 am and 8.45 am. The candidates were instructed to submit the filled in nomination papers to one of the Vice Principals upto 9.00 am. The scrutiny process was held in Xavier Hall (Common Staff Room) under the supervision of Rev. Dr. S. Aruldoss SJ,

the Vice Principal. Scrutiny of nomination papers were done by Dr. A. Paulraj, Controllers of Examinations, Dr. N. Ravi, Dr. G. Beschi, the election officers, Mr. N. M. Pushparaj, Office Superintendent and Prof. A. Vimal Jerald, the Election convener along with Heads, Coordinators and senior professor of the Department. #### **TRI FEST 2019**










# ORIENTATION PROGRAMME NEW
