Dr. Xavier Arcokiasamy, the Chairman and Principal, Rev. Dr. S. Aruldoss SJ, Advisor and Vice Principal and Prof. A. Vimal Jerald, Coordinator. This is the remarkable year as our College has been accredited as A++ Grade by NAAC. Fine Arts Association has contributed its own part during the NAAC Peer Team Visit and Team very much complimented the team for the performance staged.

As usual, the Association trained its members to nurture their talents to bring laurels to this great temple of learning. Our Teams have won many overall championship trophies and cash awards in National and State level cultural meets. The Association is very grateful to our beloved Fr. Principal and Fr. Secretary for having sectioned a considerable amount to purchase new guitar for music team, Folk team properties, and new costumes for both Dance and Theatre teams. We have convened 32 meetings totally to plan out regular activities in the College and Inter College Cultural Events. The detailed activities are reported below.

I UG ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

The orientation programme for I UG students was organised on 20-6-2019 between 8.30 a.m. and 1.30 pm, 1.45 pm and 6.30 pm for shift I and Shift II respectively. The orientation programme was inaugurated by Rev. Dr. Arockiasamy Xavier SJ, the principal. The

STUDENTS' COUNCIL ELECTIONS 2019

The candidates were instructed to submit the filled in nomination papers to one of the Vice Principals upto 9.00 am. The scrutiny process was held in Xavier Hall (Common Staff Room) under the supervision of Rev. Dr. S. Aruldoss SJ,

the Vice Principal. Scrutiny of nomination papers were done by Dr. A. Paulraj, Controllers of Examinations, Dr. N. Ravi, Dr. G. Beschi, the election officers, Mr. N. M. Pushparaj, Office Superintendent and Prof. A. Vimal Jerald, the Election convener along with Heads, Coordinators and senior professor of the Department. 

Students and Staff clothed traditional wears such as Sariee and Dhothy. Students and staff gathered large number to receive Mr. Hip hop Tamizha Adhi, a renowned music director and actor who was the chief guest. The Administrators and dignitaries were given ceremonial welcome and a honour of tying urma. They were taken to the programme venue in procession with Horse Cart with traditional attire. A formal function began at 9.30 am with Tamil Thai Vazhthu. Rev.Dr. Leonard SJ, Rector, Rev.Dr. S. Peter SJ, Secretary, felicitated the gathering. Rev. Dr. S. Aruldoss AJ, Vice Principal welcomed the gathering and introduced the chief guest. Mr. Hip hop Tamlia Adhi inspired the audience with his thought provoking speech. He also sang few songs as requested by the participants. To promote and uphold our traditional farming and arts, the college honoured Mr. Thirupathi Thangasamy, a organic farmer, Mr. Ramu, Pot Maker and Mr. Seker, Devarattam Artist. The highlight of the celebration was a mega colourful Cultural Procession, revealing the rich culture of Tamils which was flagged off by the Administrators. Even the instruments present during the whole event were all native and the audience enjoyed them to their fullest nonetheless. A paraiyattam with live parai band by our own Fine Arts students was performed. Shields and Cups were distributed to the Winners and Runners of Cultural Procession, Food Stalls and Tamil Cribs separately. 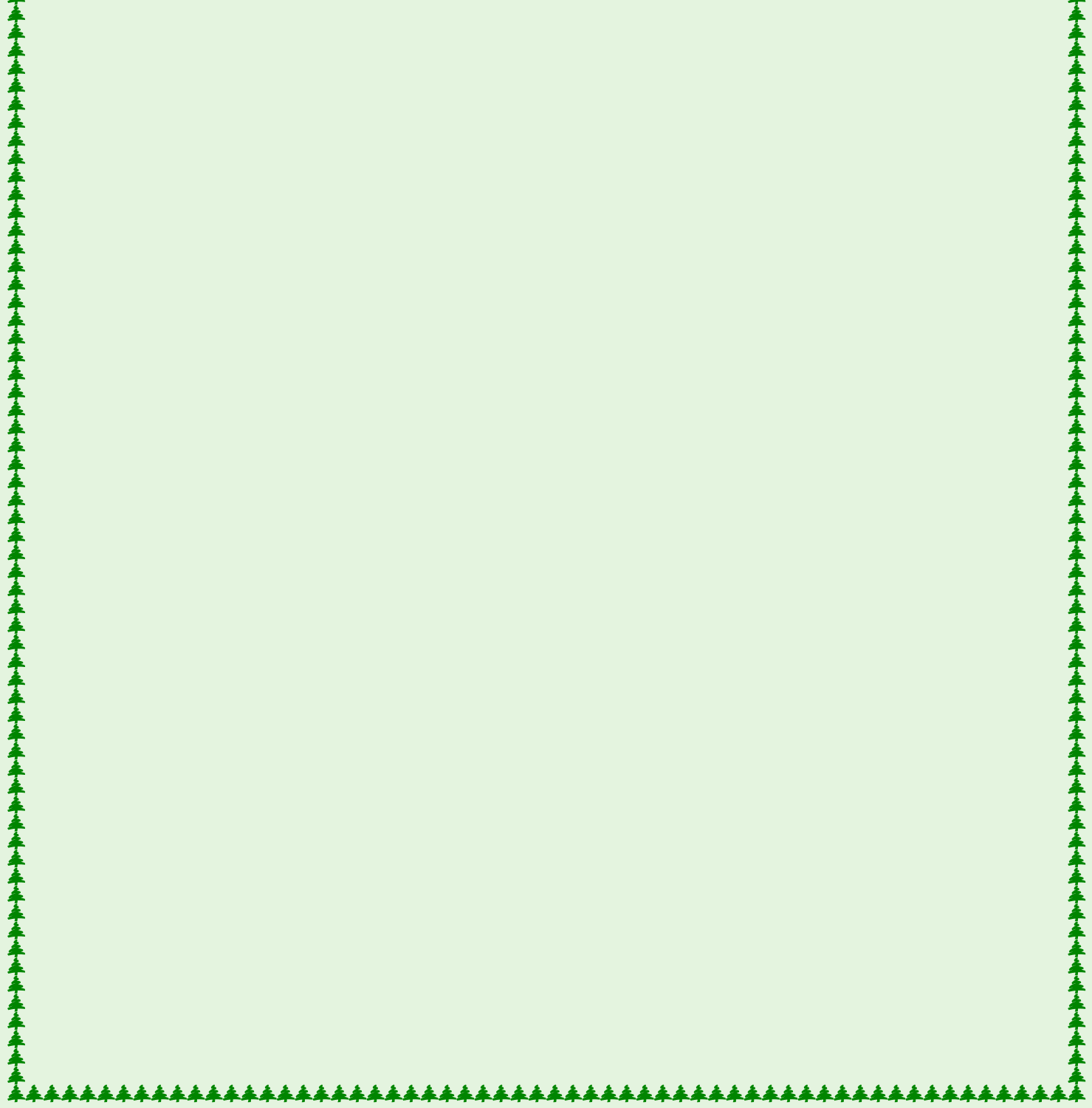

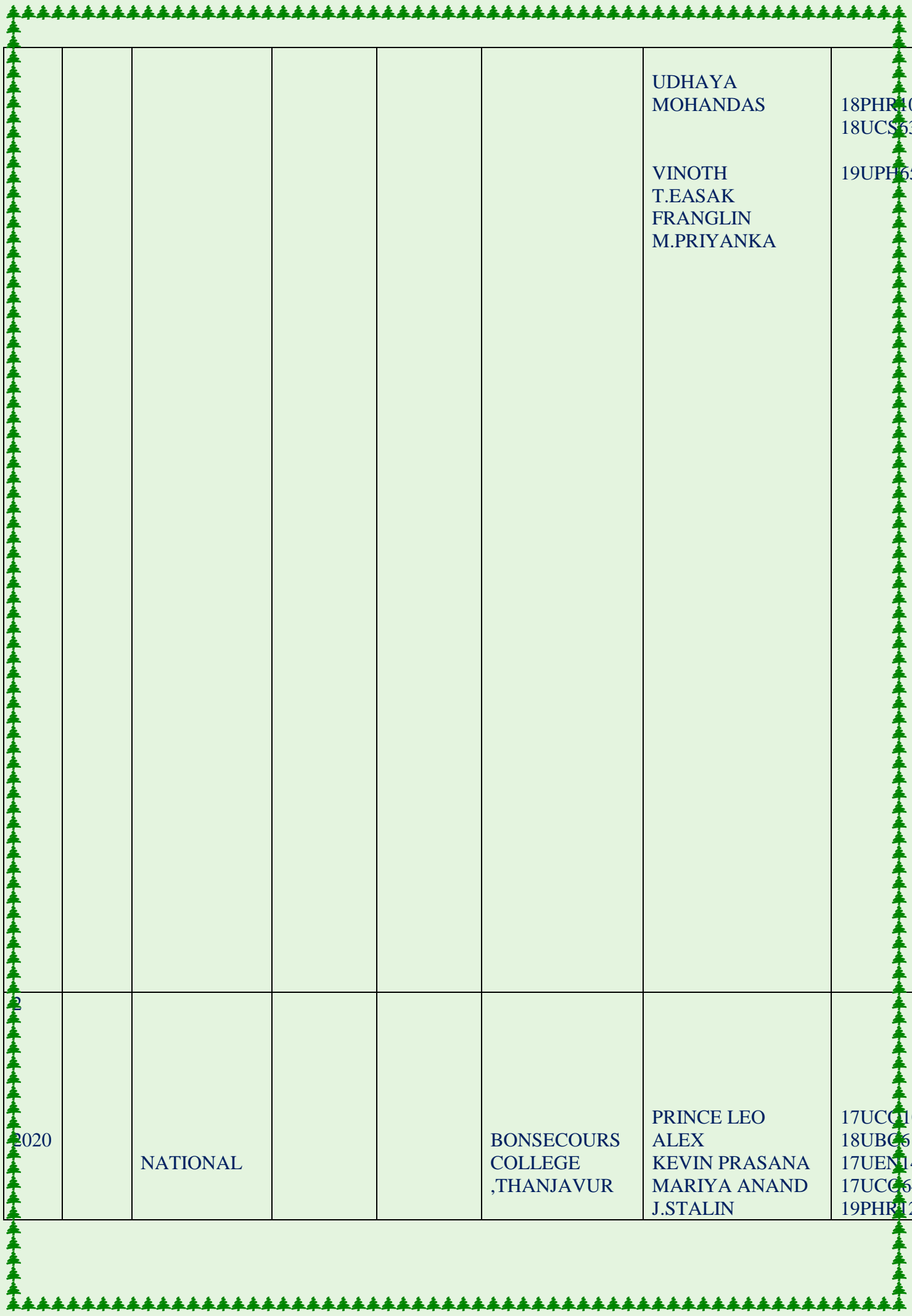

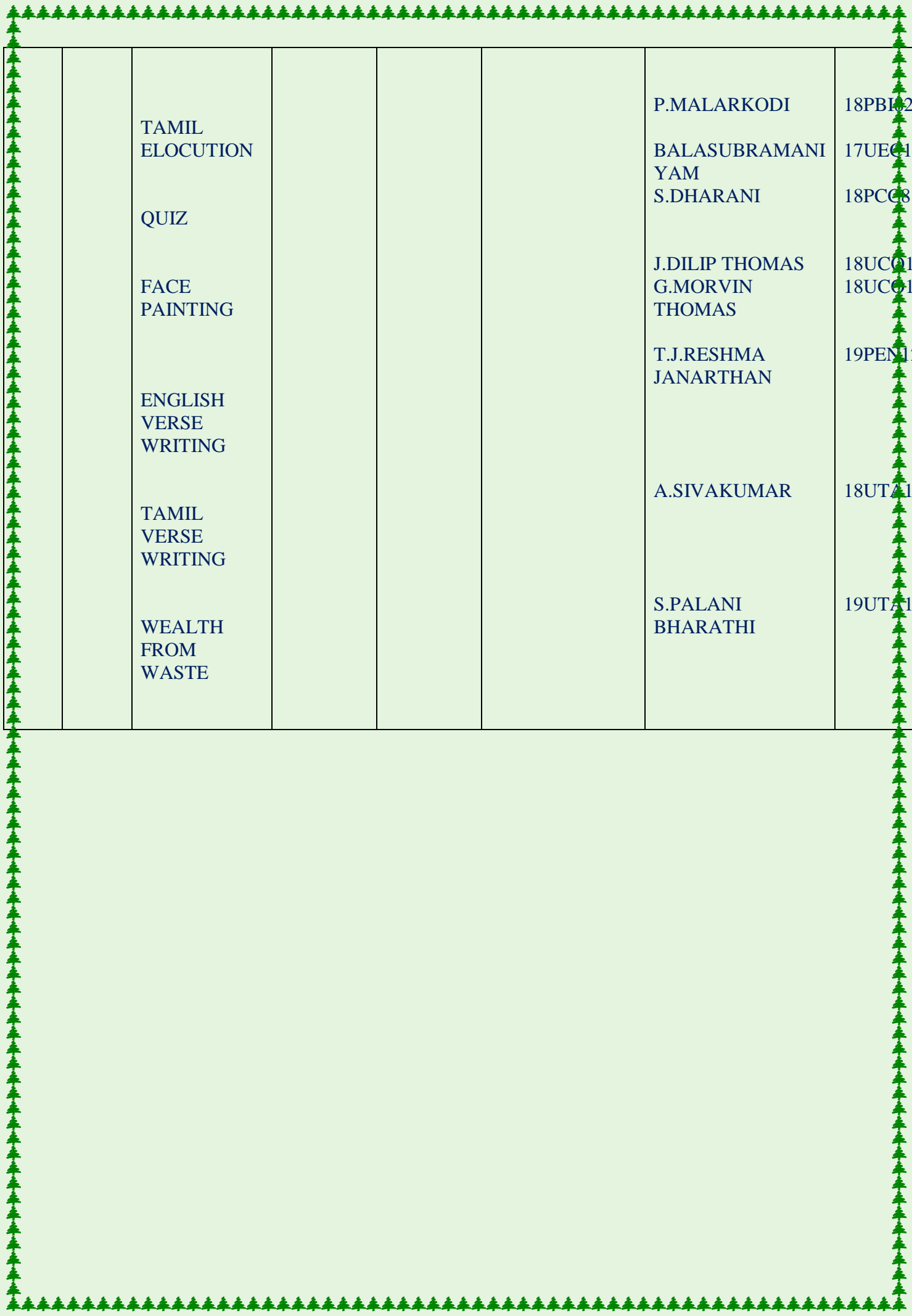
