Accordingly the NSS and NCC programme officers from various Faculty of studies were invited to attend the orientation programme on 18.03.2020 at the Conference/Syndicate Hall.

The '**Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat**' programme, aims to actively enhance interaction between people of diverse cultures living in different States and UTs in India, with the objective of promoting greater mutual understanding amongst them. As per the programme, each year, every State/UT would be paired with another State/UT in India for reciprocal



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interaction between the people. It is envisaged through this exchange, that the knowledge of the language, culture, traditions and practices of different states will lead to an enhanced understanding and bonding between one another, thereby strengthening the unity and integrity of India.

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Every State and UT in the country would be paired with another State/UT for a year, during which they would carry out a structured engagement with one another in the spheres of language, literature, cuisine, festivals, cultural events, tourism etc. For example, Taminadu is paired with Jammu Kashmir and Ladakh for the year 2020. During the year, Kashmiris would attempt to learn key words in Kashmir , a few Kashmir books would be translated into Tamil & vice-versa, Tamilians would hold food festivals offering Kashmiri dishes, Kashmiris would perform Tami folk dances, while Tamilians would perform Kashmiri traditional dance at staged events etc. The same pairing of States/ UTs will continue till June 2020. After the creation of UT of Ladakh, it has been paired along with Jammu & Kashmir with Tamil Nadu. The pairing of States/ UTs is available on the website.

Objectives of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat :

The broad objectives of the initiative are as follows



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- i. **To CELEBRATE** the Unity in Diversity of our Nation and to maintain and strengthen the fabric of traditionally existing emotional bonds between the people of our Country;

- iii. **To SHOWCASE** the rich heritage and culture, customs and traditions of either State for enabling people to understand and appreciate the diversity that is India, thus fostering a sense of common identity
- iv. **TO ESTABLISH** long-term engagements and,
- v. **TO CREATE** an environment which promotes learning between States by sharing best practices and experiences.
