

The Welcome address was given by Mrs. A.H. Komala, Assistant Professor of Economics-Education. She welcomed the Resource Person, Mrs. I.G. Anusuya, Rehabilitation Officer, National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities, Chennai.

The session started with an introduction on Inclusion, Integration and Segregation and explained the attitude towards Inclusive Education, the availability of national sources like UNCRPD, RPWD, RCI, etc. The Expert highlighted the focus of inclusion on Access, Enrollment and Retention and addressed various schemes and policies of the Government, role and responsibilities of Special Educators as well as General Teachers.

The Resource Expert gave a detailed explanation on teaching strategies and practices followed in Inclusive Education like Adaptation, Accommodation, Modification, Team teaching, Cooperative Learning, Peer tutoring, Differentiated Instruction, ContinuousComprehensive Evaluation, etc.; she also explained about how to plan and teach the concept to children with special needs, i.e., “ who is being taught, not just what is being to taught”.

Finally she deliberated on the high levels of inclusion that can be compatible with high levels of student achievement on National standard test, providing supporting services and being equitable towards all learning, it is not about denying difference between them and relationship between staff and students are critical factors in ensuring inclusive learning so, these are the impact and condition of Inclusive Education.

Finally the Expert concluded the session highlighting the major outcomes of this webinar and she also clarified the queries of the participants. The final session would have helped the participants present to advocate the use of Teaching Strategies for Diverse Learners in Inclusive setup and to implement in Education scenario. So, this webinar was the gateway for all participants to implement the right strategies for teaching diverse learners and to make a successful inclusion.




