The event began with Odisha's State song 'BANDE UTKALA JANANI'.

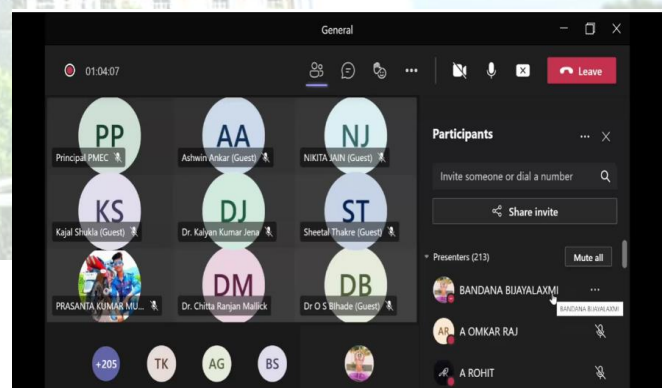
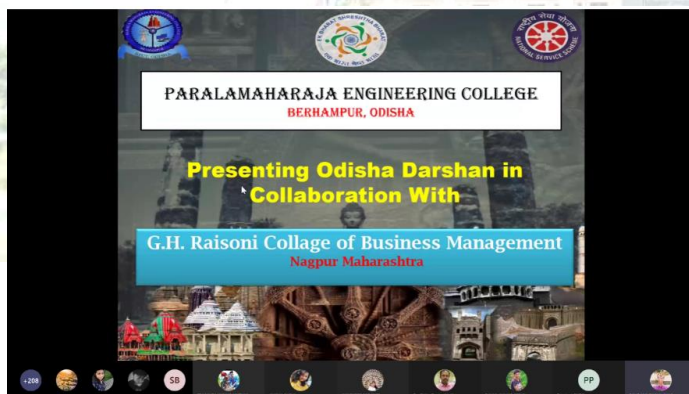

CULTURE : Lord Jagannath Temple, Puri

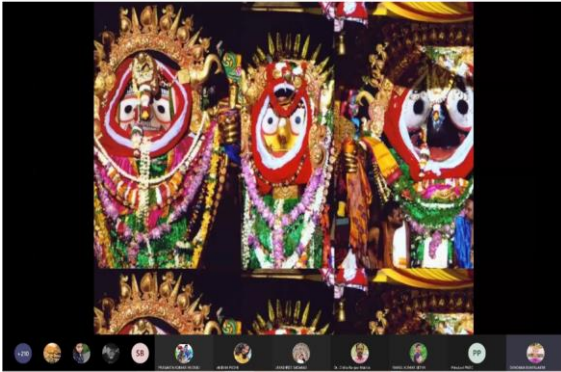
TECHNOLOGY: Konark Sun Temple, Konark
