AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON DENGUE AND SWINE FLU

Awareness Programmme on 'Dengue and Swine Flu' was organised to impart the perils of mosquitoe bites and Swine Flu.

Dengue is a mosquito borne disease transmitted by the Aedes mosquito. It is an illness affecting infants, young children and adults. Dengue is a worldwide problem, affecting the tropical and sub-tropical regions, mostly the urban and semi-urban areas. The incidence of dengue has grown dramatically around the world in recent decades. As a result, people google the ways of escaping from mosquito bites and they understand that the mosquito usually bites either at sunset or at sunrise. Mosquito sprays and mosquito mats were considered the most common choices for prevention.
