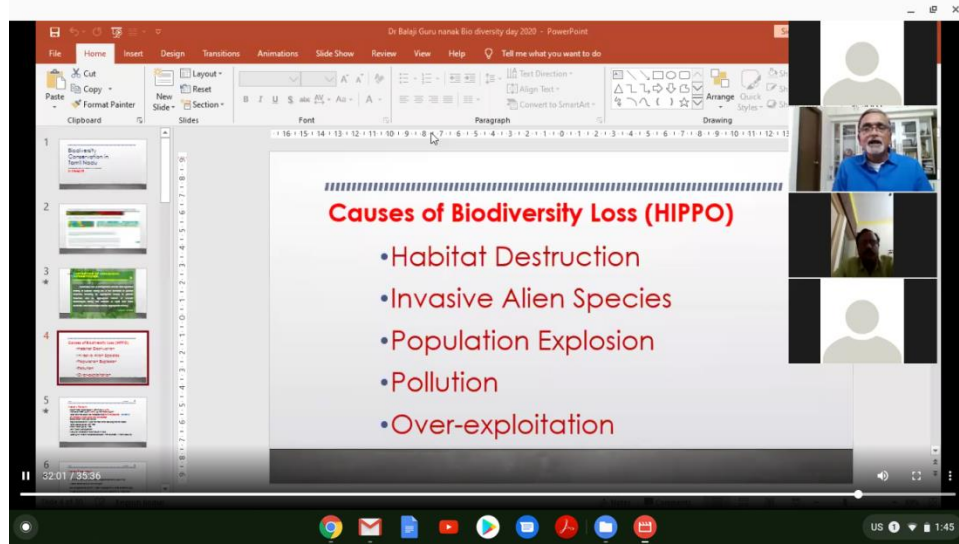
CONVENTION OF BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY(CBD)
