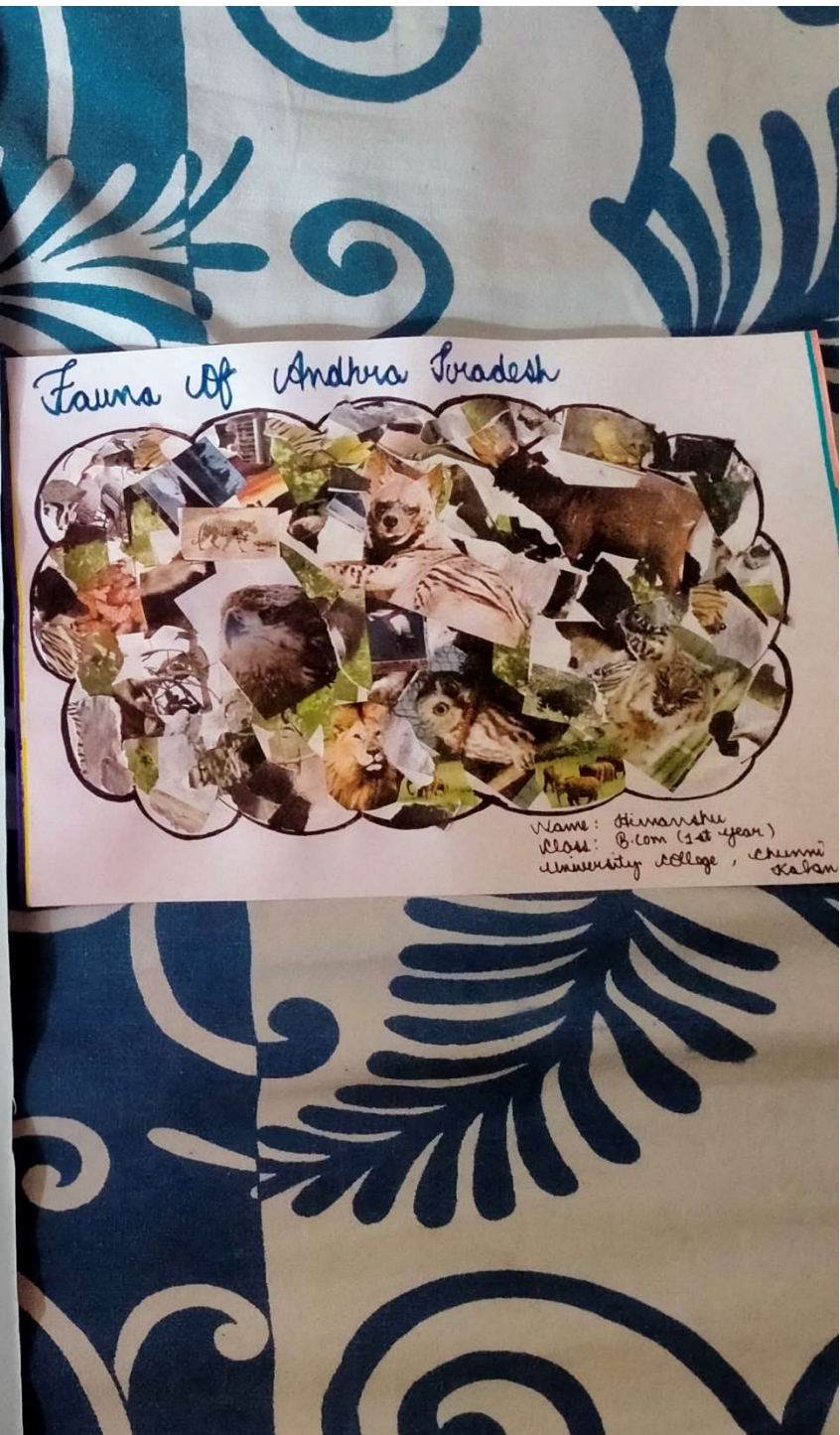
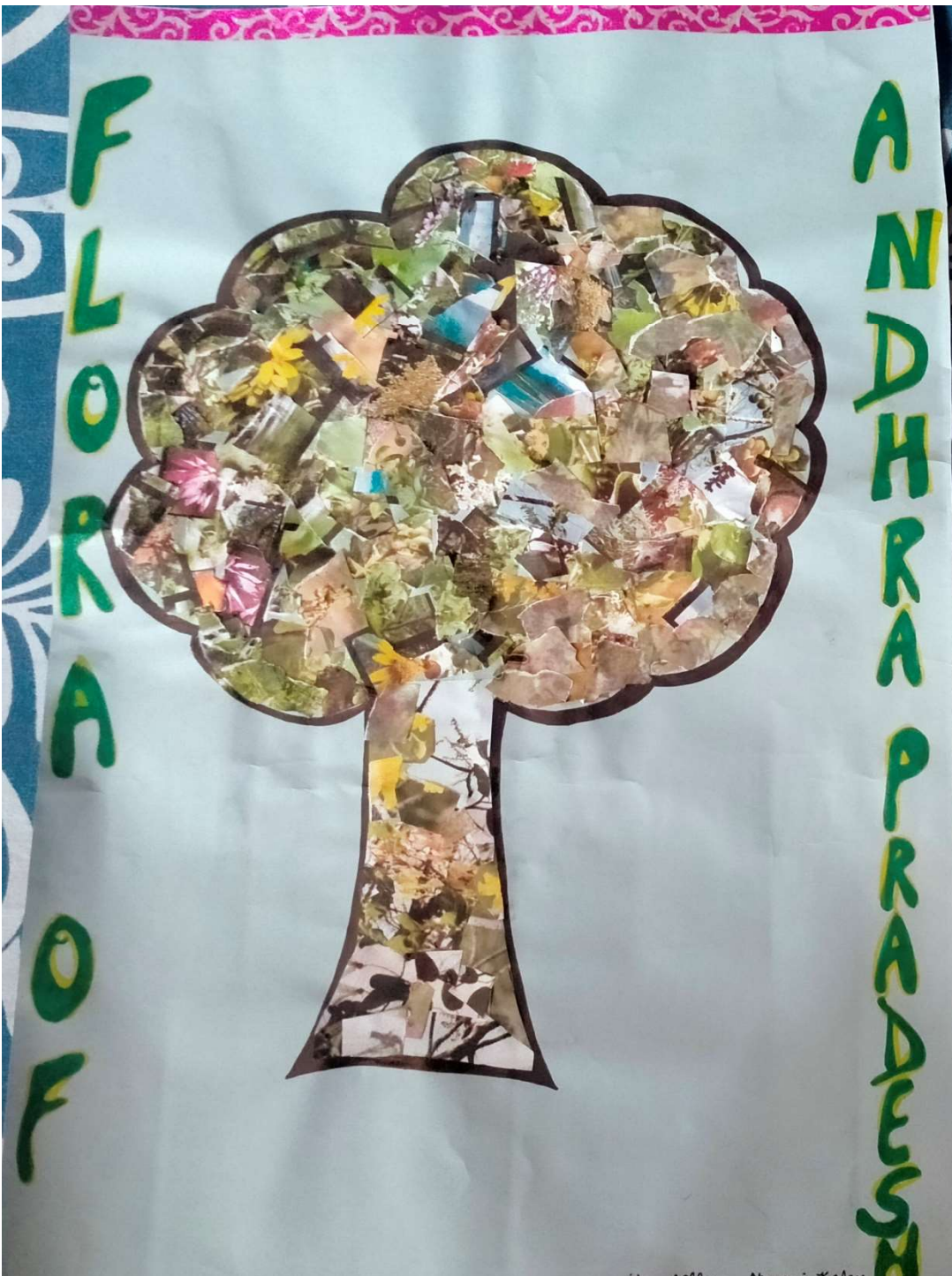
Andhra Pradesh has a wide variety of wildlife and natural beauty. It has diverse landscapes from a lush coastal area to a dry deciduous forest to a mangrove belt. The state is home to India's largest tiger reserve, in the Nallamai forest. The Godavari river delta is famous for reptiles like the salt-water crocodile, fishing cats and other exotic animals. Also India's largest pelican refuge at Kolleru Lake, which is a haven for migrating birds, is situated here.



FLORA

The state of Andhra Pradesh is endowed with rich biodiversity. Extensive field and literature survey of trees in Andhra Pradesh yielded 601 tree taxa under 295 genera belonging to 75 families out of the estimated 2900 species of flowering plants in the state.

Blessed with rich bio-diversity, Andhra Pradesh is a home to a wide variety of wildlife. The dense forests of the state beckon wildlife lovers to experience the wilderness of the National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries of the state. The state is rich in both flora and fauna.

Andhra Pradesh state comprises of mainly four **vegetation** types, a total of 2601 plant species belonging to 1035 genera and 173 families. A total of 19 Rare, Endangered and Threatened **plants** are encountered in this region.

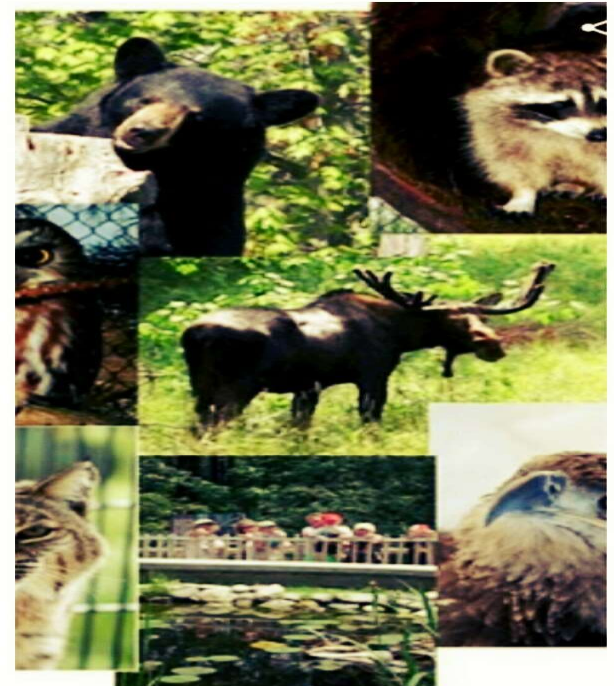
NALLAMALA HILLS: biggest forest of Andhra Pradesh



NERIUM OLEANDER: EXOTIC PLANT OF ANDHRA PRADESH









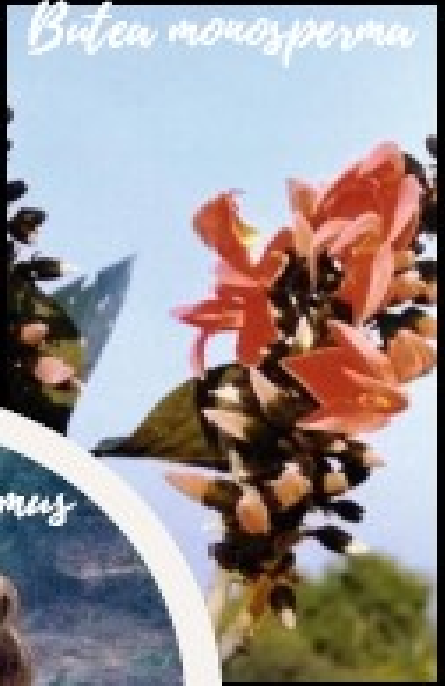
