

A programme on Dengue Awareness and Abolition of plastics was organized on 19<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Thiru R. Satish, Commissioner of Salem Corporation, Dr.Parthiban, Health Officer, Mr.Sankar, Sanitary Inspector, Mr.Vetrichelvan, Public Relation Officer and Mrs. Thilakam, Assistant Executive Engineer were present.

Dr.Parthiban, Health Officer gave an awareness on dengue prevention and told that the students should be a part of the corporation's efforts in mosquito control and dengue prevention by removing breeding sources like used tea cups, coconut shells and old tyres.
