## Attires of Maharashtrians



- Men** wear Dhoti of fine cotton cloth of about two and half to three metres long, with or without borders on both the sides. A freshly folded turbani known as 'Rumal', 'Palka' or 'Pheta'.
- Women** wear the Marathi 'Sadi' (saree) of nine yards and a short-sleeved 'Choli' (blouse) covering only about half the length of the back.
- Foot Wear**  
Kolhapuri Chappals manufactured in Kolhapur and its surrounding towns and villages are famous worldwide.
- Jewellery**  
Maharashtrian women wear traditional jewellery patterns of the Marathas and Peshwas. The Kolhapuri 'Saaj', a special type of necklace is the most famous jewellery.
