

# MINUTES OF ENGLISH LITERARY ASSOCIATION

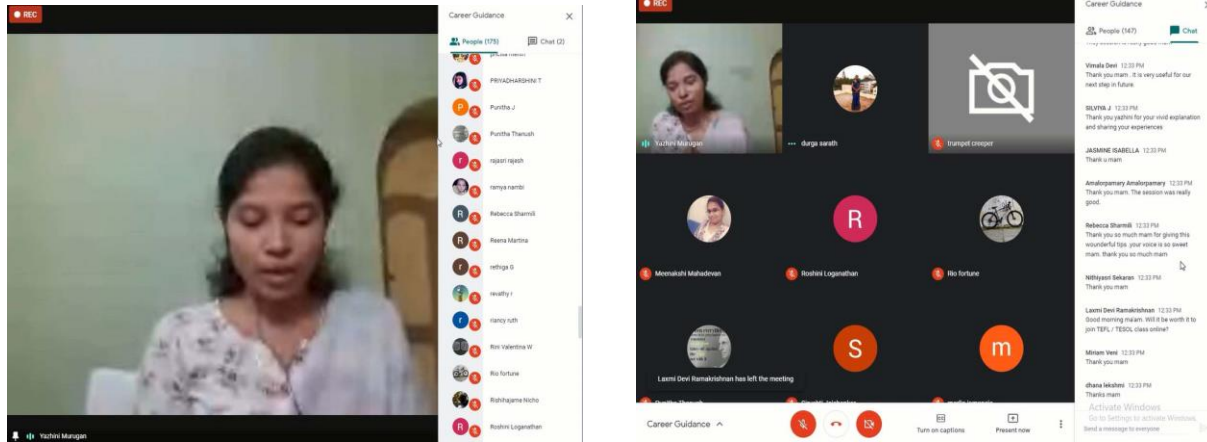

The session was taken over by the resource person. She listed out the scopes for further studies - M.B.A., Law, Journalism and Media Studies after they complete their B.A., English. She spoke about how resume creates an impact in a recruiter and gave ideas of designing a resume. Then she spoke about financial literacy and decision making. Later she listed four types of learners- Visual, Auditory, Kinaesthetic and oral learners. She spoke about the importance of IELTS where there is band score for each of the four skills in English. Taking a diagnostic test to understand where they are, will enable the students to improve for better. Emotional Intelligence matters a lot says she and suggests that it is always a good choice for the students to decide on their own, while they plan for higher studies. . Guidance was also given for students in becoming a freelancer in the fields of Human Resource, Marketing. She also added that planning for a part- time job along with their studies would help them grow better. She pointed out that one should possess skills and values along with a degree to acquire a job.
