

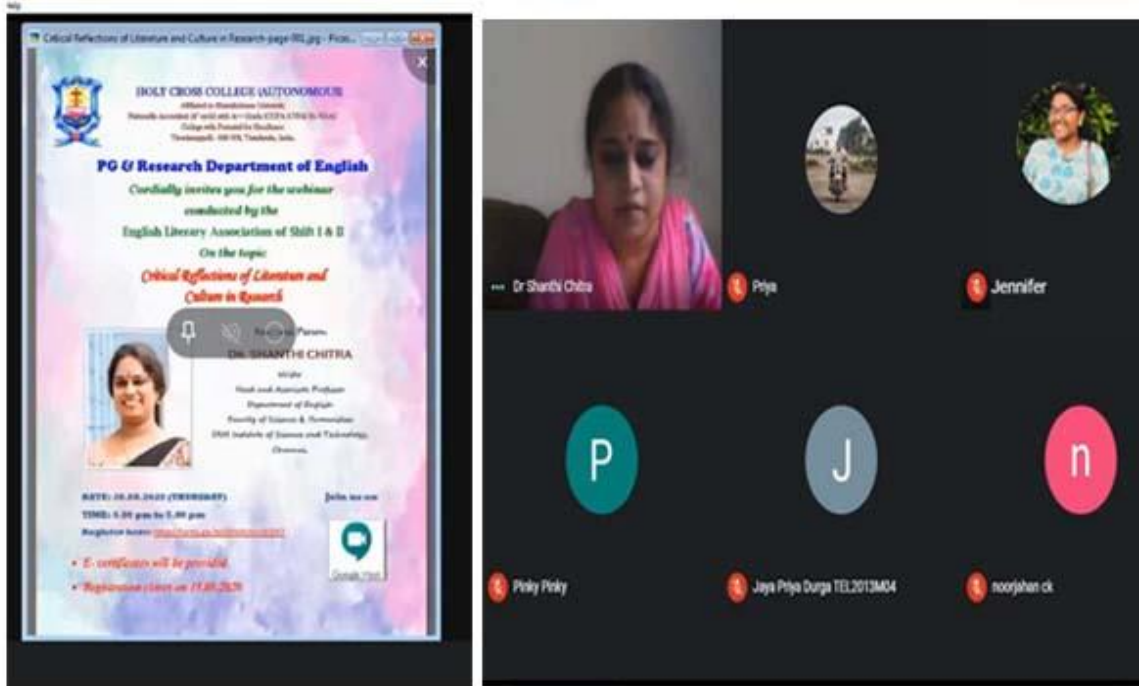
MINUTES OF ENGLISH LITERARY ASSOCIATION


