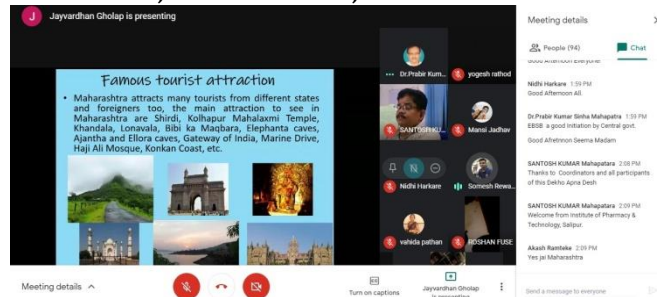
## Report on “Insights of Magnificent Maharashtra” under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat


