
PIMR LITERACY MISSION (2019-20)

The PIMR Literacy mission has kept the spirit high in this session as well with aim to teach the underprivileged children of slum area along with educating and instilling them with the sense of responsibility and awareness about environmental factors and issues. Various audio-video techniques such as movies, clips, PPTs, etc. were used to educate them about etiquettes, teamwork, social issues, hygiene, motivation, etc.

Steps followed in Literacy Mission



Following are the curricular and extra-curricular activities carried on during July, 2019 to March, 2020:

- Four classes per week are conducted by student volunteers and faculty coordinators.
- Student volunteers adopt white-board mode, audio, video and various learn with fun activities to teach children.
- Children are taught as per their course. Their problems in various subjects were asked and identified so that taught them accordingly.
- Children are also directed for their daily home-work.
- Tables, alphabate (Hindi & English), Dictation, etc. are also taught as and when required.
- Other than subject-based classes volunteers also teach children to introduce themselves,
- Moral and motivational stories are also narrated to children to build their morale and confidence. They are also taught about basic etiquettes and hygiene.
- Poems and story narration (with action) are also made learnt to children.
- The art and craft classes are also conducted by the volunteer students of PIMR. In these classes drawing, painting and clay art are taught to the children by providing them the required stationery and materials.
- Student volunteers also conduct classes at the various centres of Sewa Bharti, NGO.
