The Department of Hindi, GNC conducted a two day International Workshop on "Hindi **Journalism: Challenges & Opportunities**" from 31st August, 2020 to 1st September, 2020. It was an e-workshop for the benefit of student community and teachers of Non Hindi areas. More than 215 people registered for the event. The Chief Guest & Resource Person for the first session was Mr. Suresh Chandra Shukla, Journalist - Editor from Oslo, Norway. He is publishing a Hindi magazine in Norway for last 35 years. He spoke about the Hindi Journalism in Global Scenario. He shared his thoughts about difficulties and challenges of a Hindi journalist in other countries. More than 120 faculty members & students from different part of India participated in this session which started at 4 pm on Monday, 31.08.2020. The inaugural session of the workshop was convened by Dr. Swati Paliwal, Dean, School of Languages. It started with the college prayer. The Principal Dr. M G Ragunathan gave the welcome address, following which the Chief Guest was introduced by Mrs. Narayani Choubey. A lively question - answer session was then conducted by Dr. Dolly. Dr. Asha Chaturvedi, gave the vote of thanks for this session. The resource person for the day II was Dr. P. S. Vijay Raghavan. He is the editor in charge of Chennai Edition of Rajasthan Patrika, the only national Hindi daily of India with a Chennai edition. He emphasized on learning the local languages to establish reputation and trust. This Valedictory session started at 4pm with the welcome address of Vice Principal Dr. LRS Kalanidhi. Mrs. Guria Choudhary spoke about the objectives of the workshop. Dr. Anita Patil did the compering. Dr. Dolly gave the introduction of the Chief Guest. After the resource person's presentation, a question - answer session was conducted by Mrs. Narayani Choubey. More than 125 participants attended this session. Apart from Tamil Nadu, participants from Odisha, Assam, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, UP and Puducherry also attended the workshop. In the end, Dr. Swati Paliwal presented the report of the workshop and gave vote of thanks. After taking the feedback from the participants, E-certificates were issued.
