## JAYKRUSHNA RAJGURU MAHAPATRA (JAYEE RAJGURU)

October 29, 1739 - 6 December, 1806

- A princely priest by profession at the court of the raja of Khurda, Rajguru was the first person to revolt against the British Raj in the province. He came to be known as Jayee Rajguru after his appointment as 'Rajguru' to the king.
- Rajguru not only proved to be a great royal priest but also an accomplished Commander-in-Chief and a freedom fighter.
- He was the first martyr in the national freedom struggle from Orissa.

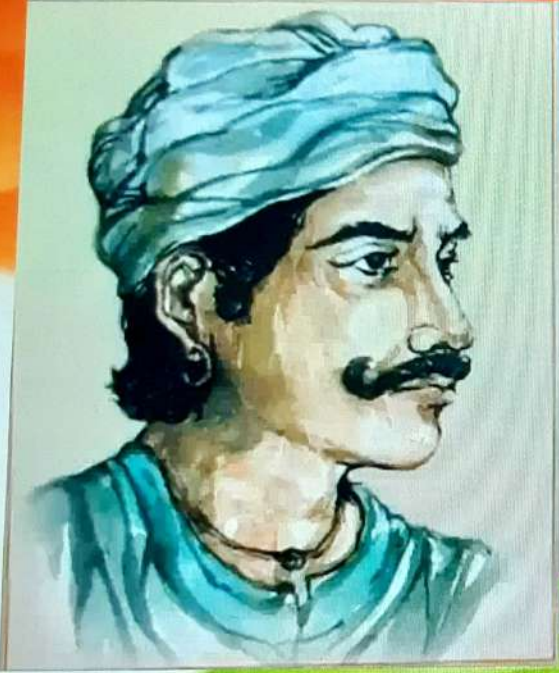

## BAKSHI JAGABANDHU

1773 - 1829 (aged 55-56)

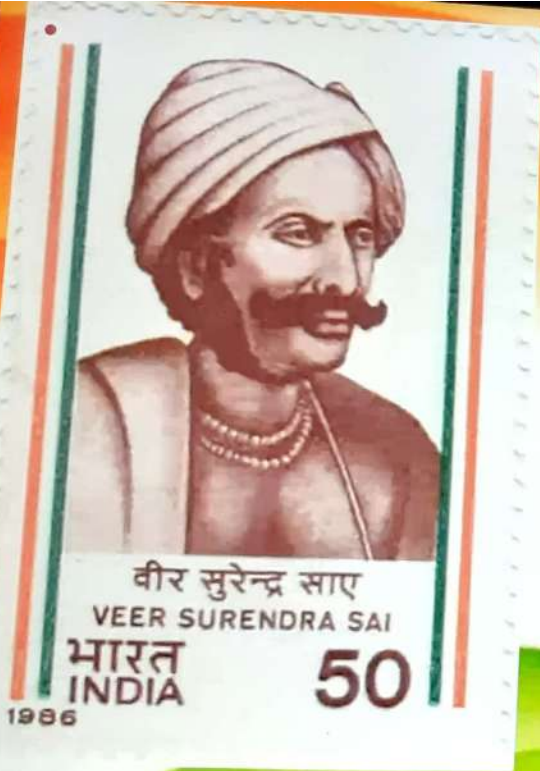


- When the British started tinkering with the revenue system in 1803, the farming community of Odisha rose in rebellion. At that critical juncture, Bakshi Jagabandhu Bidyadhar the military chief of the King of Khurda led his motley army of Paikas forcing the British East India Company forces to retreat.
- Jagabandhu Bidyadhara had got the title of Bakshi in inheritance from his ancestors which represents the rank of the commander of the forces of the King of Khurda.
- The Paikas rose in rebellion under their leader Bakshi Jagabandhu and, projecting Jagannath as the symbol of Odia unity.

## VEER SURENDRA SAI

23 January 1809 - 28 February 1884

- Sai espoused the cause of the downtrodden tribal people in Sambalpur
- The Indian Revolution collapsed by the end of 1858 and law and order was restored by the British throughout India, but he continued his revolution.
- His aim was to drive the British out of his native Sambalpur, and though he could not succeed in his goal, he inspired a generation of freedom fighters in Odisha, and Jharkhand later on.





## MALATI DEVI CHOUDHURY

26 July 1904 - 15 March 1998

- She was tagore's favourite "minu" and gandhiji used to call her "tofanee"
- She had established the bajiraut chhatravas at angul in orissa in 1946.
- She had organized the 'krusaka andolana' (farmers movement)
- After independence, malati choudhury was a member of the constituent assembly of india, and the president of the utkal pradesh congress committee.
- She highlighted the plight of the have-nots, particularly those belonging to the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes.





## BAJI ROUT

5 October 1926 - 11 October 1938

- The youngest martyr in history of the freedom movement of india
- He joined Prajamandal Movement in early childhood
- He stood against the oppressive ruler of Dhenkanal.
- His famous line in this incident: **"This boat of mine belongs to the Praja Mandal. It cannot be hired out to you — the enemy of the people."**

## VINAYAK DAMODAR SAVARKAR

28, May 1883 - 26, February 1966

- Also known as '*Swatantryaveer Savarkar*'
- Education: Bachelor of Arts from Fergusson College, Pune, Maharashtra. He was barrister.
- Known for- Indian independence activist and politician who formulated *Hindutva* (Hinduness). He was a leading figure in the *Hindu Mahasabha*.
- In 1910, Savarkar was arrested and ordered to be extradited to India. Savarkar was sentenced to two life terms of imprisonment totaling fifty years and was moved to the Cellular Jail (aka *Kala Pani*) in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
- After his release from jail, he worked on the abolishment of untouchability in Ratnagiri.

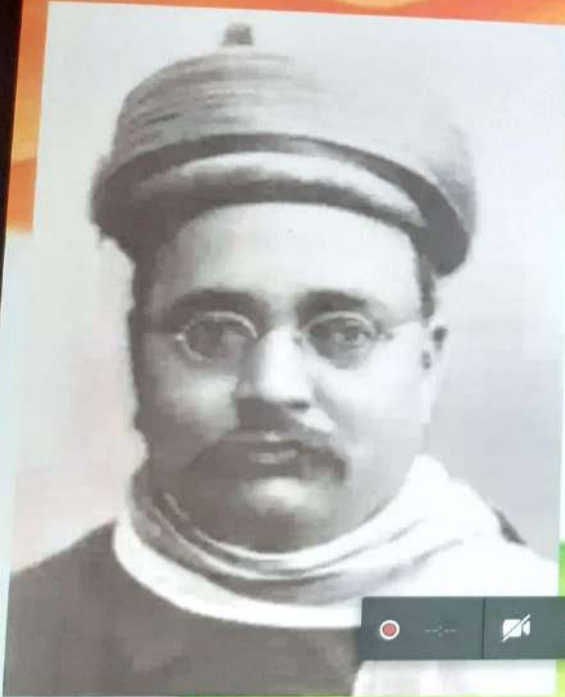




## KESHAV GANGADHAR TILAK

23 July 1856 - 1 August 1920

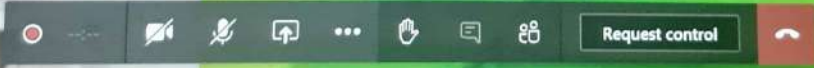
- Also known as '*Bal Gangadhar Tilak or Lokmanya Tilak*'.
- Known for- Indian nationalist, teacher, an independence activist, Author and politician. "The father of the Indian unrest". Mahatma Gandhi called him "The Maker of Modern India".
- Tilak sparked the fire for complete independence in Indian consciousness and is considered the father of Hindu nationalism as well.
- "***Swaraj is my birthright, and I shall have it!***" This famous quote of his very popular and well-remembered in India even today.



## GOPAL KRISHNA GOKHALE

Born- 9 May 1866 - 19 February 1915

- Known for- An Indian liberal political leader and a social reformer during the Indian Independence Movement. The founder of the Servants of India Society.
- He was the leader of the moderate faction of the Congress party that advocated reforms by working with existing government institutions.
- For Gokhale, true political change in India would only be possible when a new generation of Indians became educated as to their civil and patriotic duty to their country and to each other.

## VASUDEV BALWANT PHADKE

4 November 1845 - 17 February 1883

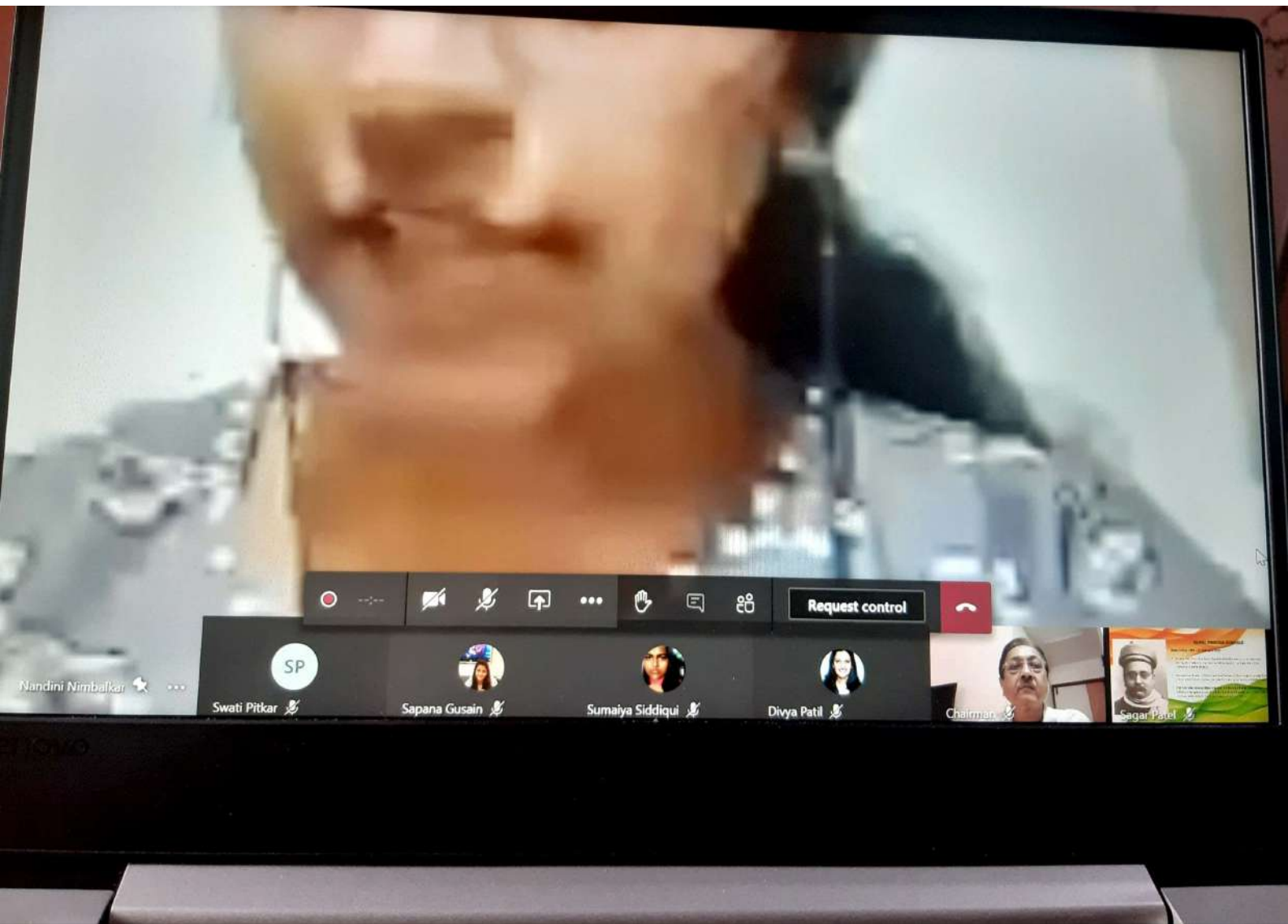
- Known for- Revolutionary and Indian independence activist. known as the "*Father of the Indian armed rebellion*". Phadke, who once escaped jail by ripping a prison door off its hinges, had developed a public culture of patriotism. He believed that Swaraj was the only remedy for their ills.
- Phadke issued his famous proclamation denouncing the exploitative economic policies of the government and warned them in May 1879. creating a sensation throughout the country.




## Dr. BHIMRAO RAMJI AMBEDKAR

Born- 14 April 1891 - 6 December 1956

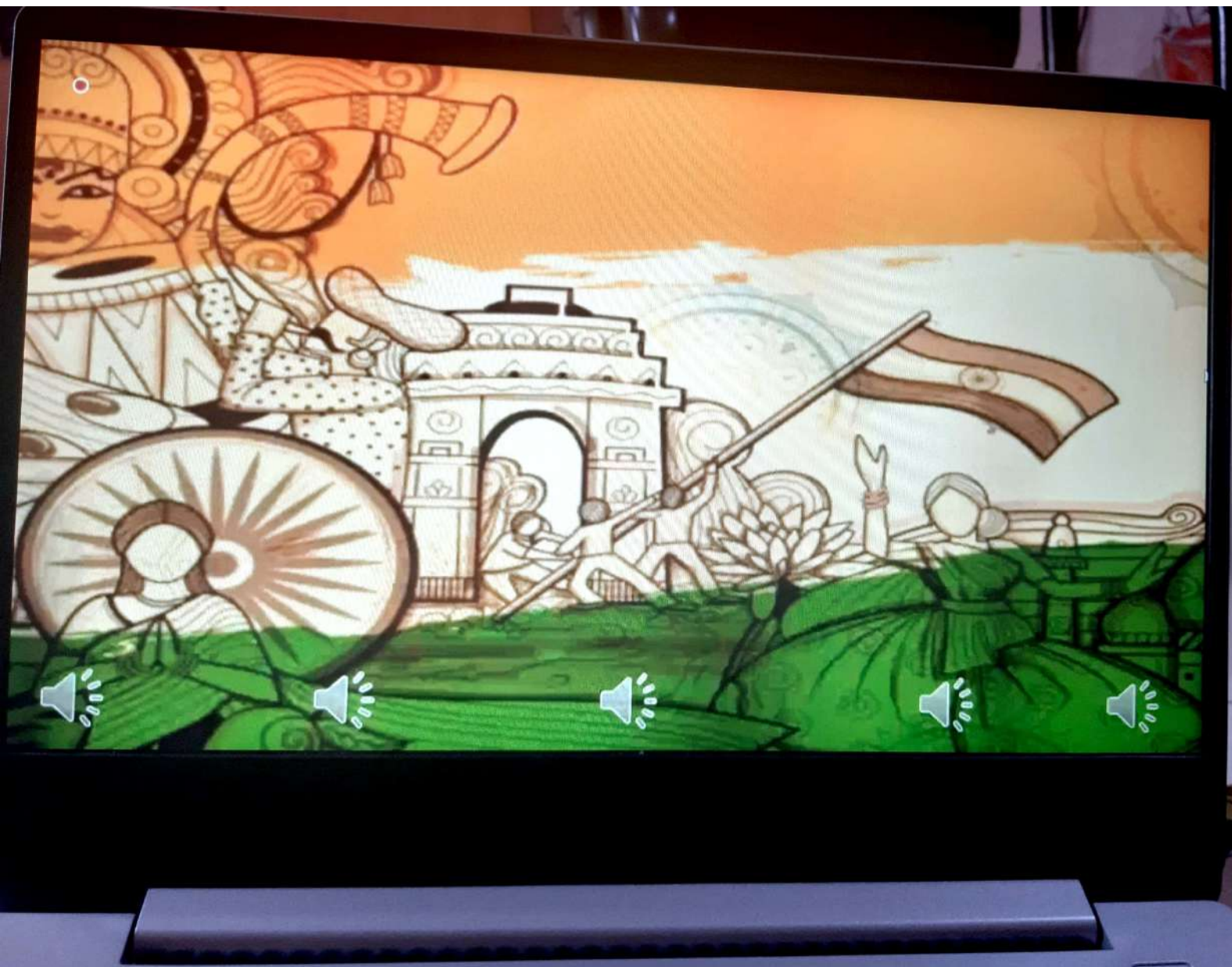
- Known for- Ambedkar is recognized as the "*Father of the Constitution of India*". Forming many organizations for the empowerment of the Dalit. In framing the constitution of independent India, he played a leading role. He was appointed as the Chairman of the constitution drafting committee in 1947.
- "*Law and order are medicine of the body politic and when the body politic gets sick, medicine must be administered.*" is one of his famous lines.

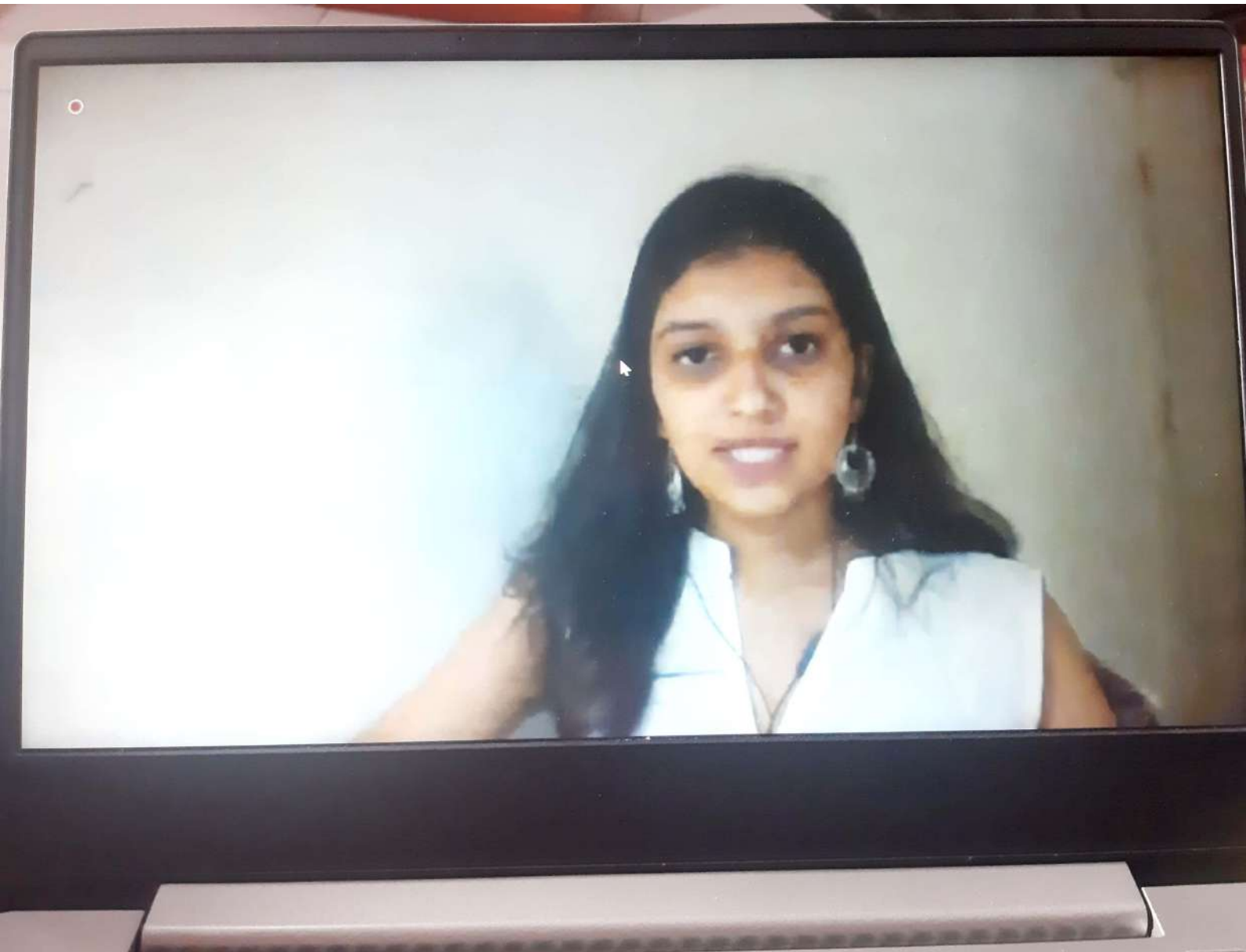
