Webinar on “Cultural History of SIKKIM”
















Sikkim was a protectorate first of British India and after its independence in 1947 of India. *On the 11th of September 2020 a webinar was organized by Banarsidas Chandiwala Institute of Hotel Management & Catering Technology, on the Cultural History of Sikkim.*

The students learnt about Sikkim being a Buddhist kingdom under the Namgyal-Chogyal dynasty during the period 1642 - 1975, defending itself against attacks from Nepal. It was new to know for everyone that before 1835 Darjeeling had been part of Sikkim until annexed by British India. Further Radha , a Vth semester student threw light on how Sikkim became more severely restricted when the new Constitution was formed in the year 1955. She elaborated how , Bureaucrats planned to bring the monarchy to an end in 1973 and India in turn, increased its influence. The Chogyal (king who governs) with Palden Namgyal Thodup was crashed in 1975 and Sikkim hence Attained its identity as 22nd state of the country

The beautifully woven cultural traits such as dress and family norms reflects close affinity with the Khasi (tribe) of Meghalaya, and respectively how do they have lot in common with the Tangkul Naga (a major ethnic group) of the Northern Manipur was explained by Arnav , a Vth semester student .

The webinar was attended and conducted by the 3rd year students , to gain knowledge about the history and background of the beautiful state surrounded by the Himalayan ranges , steep paths leading to a calm hilltop. This knowlegable webinar and interactive session was conducted under the supervision of Mr.Siddharth Srivastava and Mr. Manish Malhotra.
