USES OF BAMBOO IN MANIPUR:

The Manipuri people's lives are inextricably linked to bamboo. It is critical to the local people's socioeconomic well-being because they rely on it for their livelihood. Bamboo is used in various religious events as well as for house construction, food, fuel, fodder, tool production, and other household necessities. Bamboo is also commonly utilised in the handicraft business to create beautiful things. Bamboo is required from conception to death, and it is a cultural tradition for people to grow bamboo in their



houses. Almost every household has a bamboo colony on their private property.



They classify different bamboo varieties based on their intended applications, such as bamboo for construction, bamboo for ritual, bamboo for usage in people's daily lives, and bamboo for food. Bamboo shoots, which are the immature juvenile culms of bamboo plants that emerge from underground rhizomes, have long been a popular food item in this region and are used in a variety of traditional dishes. The majorities of the species that grow in Manipur are edible and

can be eaten. Fresh young shoots, as well as fermented variants, are widely consumed as vegetables or additions in this state.
