Mera Hou Chongba, also known as Mera Waayungba or Mera Thaomei Thaanba, is a Manipur cultural celebration of solidarity that is observed by all indigenous ethnic groups in the state, including the Meitei and other hill tribes. The 15th lunar day of the Meitei calendar's Mera month falls on this day. The Sana Konung, Manipur's Royal Palace, is the major venue for the festival's celebrations. On this day, all of the hill



tribes descended upon Imphal's valley, gathered at the Royal Palace, and performed cultural dances and various forms of art. The day concludes with a great feast hosted by the Meitei people and tribes to demonstrate solitude among people of all ethnic groups in the region.
